# MINUTES REGULAR MEETING

5:00 PM August 10, 2010

## PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was given by President Caspary.

#### 1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

A Call to order and roll call.

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by President Caspary in the District offices. Secretary Peterson called the roll. Those answering present were Directors Bowman, Caspary, Peterson and Renger.

Director Smith was absent - excused.

## 2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

A Approval of agenda.

On a motion by Director Lee Renger, seconded by Director Glen Peterson, the Board of Directors voted 4-0 -1 to Approve the Regular Meeting of August 10, 2010 as amended by General Manager Mundy's recommendation to hear agenda item 4B Measuring and Developing Best Practices for a High Performance Water District prior to 4A Total Compensation Study Update - Fox Lawson & Associates.

#### 3. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Eight speaker cards were received from the public. (1) Linda Stock commented on the enforceability of the unsigned T-Mobile agreement and requested Legal Counsel Lemieux provide her with the legal statue related to enforcement of the agreement, President Caspary requested Legal Counsel Lemieux respond to the customer; (2) Liat Samouhi commented on

and entered into public record a 16-page report entitled "Review of the Proposed T-Mobile Wireless Telecommunications Installation Site ID SV11193D Mulwood Water Tank Near 3370 Adamsville Avenue, Calabasas, California 91302 Prepared for Tanterra Condominium Association, Inc. by Harry Tarnoff, BSEE - DataPlex, Inc., and stated she has a petition with 170+ homeowner signatures who are against the cell tower; (3) Ben Rodriguez discussed his experiences with City of Calabasas, Public Records Act not met and only a portion of the records were disclosed, sound report was from gun range, talked to T-Mobile regarding an alternate location, and City of Calabasas manager(s) have refused their meeting request; (4) Don Zimring representing Las Virgenes Unified School District (LVUSD) discussed the schools relationship with Las Virgenes, LVUSD has taken pay cuts, would like Las Virgenes' water bills to be redesigned to include a \$1 donation section for school district use to help offset their water bills and requested Las Virgenes utilize its outreach funds by using school district computers, etc for outreach; (5) Jill Gaines stated her support for the LVUSD proposal to parter with Las Virgenes; (6) Mayor Bill Koehler representing City of Agoura Hills discussed support of LVUSD's proposal to redirect advertising funds from Las Virgenes to LVUSD; (7) Mayor Barry Groveman representing City of Calabasas advocates use of advertising funds and deflated rates for the school district; and (8) Howard Rodgers on behalf of himself and Mountain View Estates thanked staff and the Board for their efforts on the water allocation and penalty process.

Director Bowman requested the report from Tanterra be provided to T-Mobile and President Caspary requested staff place on the next agenda an item discussing LVUSD's proposals.

A Total Compensation Study Update - Fox Lawson & Associates

Bruce Lawson of Fox Lawson & Associates discussed the process for conducting of a Total Compensation Study. Directors Bowman and Caspary requested periodic status updates be provided to the entire Board of Directors with actual information and without staff edits; and would appreciate input as to which agencies Las Virgenes should compare to in the future.

This item was heard prior to agenda item 4A Total Compensation Study Update - Fox Lawson & Associates.

Dr. Bill Mathis made a presentation and discussed organizational culture, measurement of efficiency, development of existing team to be a better culture, Board instrument is measurement of customer satisfaction.

After a discussion with Dr. Mathis, General Manager Mundy and the Board of Directors, President Caspary directed General Manager Mundy to bring back a scope of work for services to be reviewed by the Board.

One speaker card was received from Pete McCawley who was representing the property owner. Mr. McCawley stated that the owner does not want to detach from Las Virgenes, but District No. 29 notified them that water wheeling was not an option and the owner somehow needs to either have water for, and/or implement 3 of their 8 water service agreements.

On a motion by Director Glen Peterson, seconded by Director Joseph Bowman, the Board of Directors voted 4-0 -1 to Approve w/ Conditions the recommendation as presented with a provision based on comments from General Manager Mundy and Legal Counsel Lemieux to continue negotiations for a temporary water wheeling agreement between the property owner, District No. 29 and Las Virgenes through the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO).
