# BOIL WATER NOTICE

Boil Your Water Before Drinking or Food Preparation to Avoid Illness

Due to the recent Woolsey Fire, the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Drinking Water, the Los Angeles County Health Department, and the Las Virgenes Municipal Water District are advising residents to only use boiled tap water or bottled water for drinking and cooking purposes as a safety precaution to avoid stomach or intestinal illness. The affected area includes: the area south of Westlake Village, east of the Ventura County line, north of the City of Malibu and west of Corral Canyon. Please see the attached map for additional details.

We will inform you when tests show that water is safe to drink and you no longer need to boil your water. We anticipate resolving the problem within several days.

### Do not drink the water without boiling it first



- Boil all water for one (1) minute (rolling boil).
- Let water cool before drinking.
- Use boiled or bottled water for drinking, brushing teeth, and food preparation until further notice.
- Boiling water kills bacteria and other organisms in the water.

### If you are unable to boil your water:

#### Household unscented liquid bleach



- For clear water, use 8 drops (1/8 tspn.) of bleach for 1 gallon of water. For cloudy water, filter through a clean cloth and use 16 drops (1/4 tspn.) of bleach for 1 gallon of water.
- Mix well. Allow to stand for 30 minutes before using.
- Water may taste or smell like chlorine. This means disinfection has occurred.

#### Water disinfection tablets



- Please follow the manufacturer's instructions.

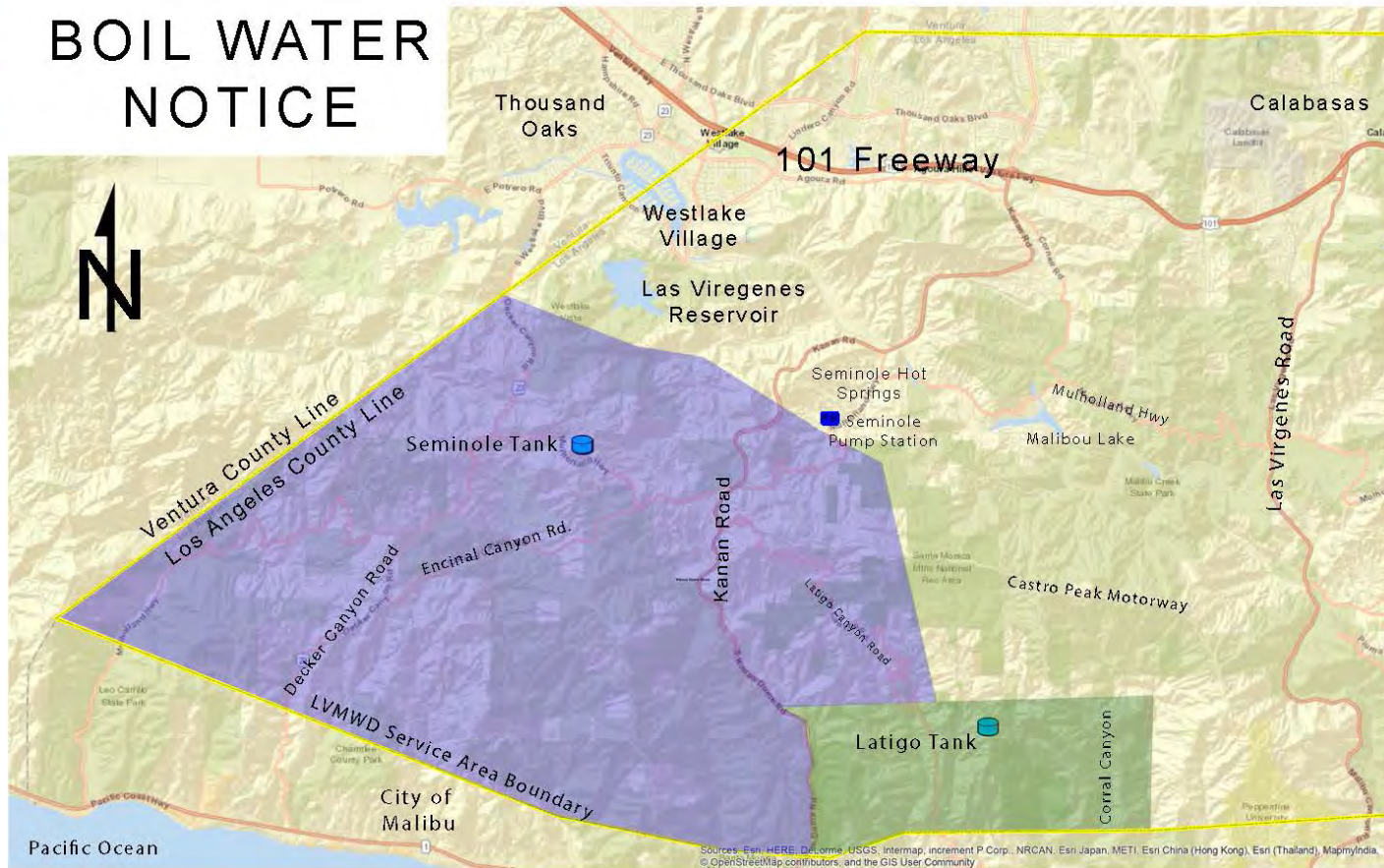




# BOIL WATER NOTICE
