1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order at <u>9:00 a.m.</u> by Board President Lewitt in the Board Room at Las Virgenes Municipal Water District headquarters at 4232 Las Virgenes Road, Calabasas, CA 91302. Josie Guzman, Clerk of the Board, conducted the roll call.

<u>Director Renger</u> moved to approve the agenda. Motion seconded by <u>Director Caspary</u>. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Director Polan</u> moved to approve the Consent Calendar. Motion seconded by <u>Director Renger</u>. Motion carried unanimously.

5. <u>ILLUSTRATIVE AND/OR VERBAL PRESENTATION AGENDA ITEMS</u>

A MWD Representative Report

Glen Peterson, MWD Representative, provided an update regarding San Diego County Water Authority's counterproposal to MWD's Section 998 Settlement Offer in the litigation against MWD. He noted that the MWD Board was not expected to respond to the counterproposal because a Section 998 Settlement Offer is not intended to be countered. He also reported that the MWD Board approved and authorized the distribution of Appendix A for use in the issuance and remarketing of MWD's bonds; inducted new Director Heather Repenning from the City of Los Angeles and new Director Michael Camacho from the Inland Empire Utilities Agency; and adopted the updated State Legislative Priorities and Principles for 2020.

Director Caspary inquired whether the MWD Board had addressed language that exempts the Legislature from the California Administrative Procedures Act, which would circumvent review by public agencies. Mr. Peterson responded that MWD would oppose such a bill.

Board President Lewitt asked Mr. Peterson to bring back MWD's overview regarding levels of perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) in the water it provides to its member agencies.

B Legislative and Regulatory Updates

Joe McDermott, Director of Engineering and External Affairs, provided an update regarding H.R. 535 related to PFAS. He noted that January 24th was the deadline to submit bill requests to the State legislative counsel. He also provided an update regarding the District's legislative proposal related to emergency backup generators, which would be co-sponsored by the California Municipal Utilities Association. He noted that February 17th would be the deadline to introduce new bills. He also reported that he would provide testimony at an informational hearing of the Assembly Water, Parks, and Wildlife Committee on February 11th entitled, "What Happens to Water Supplies during Power Shutoffs."

C Water Supply Conditions Update

Joe McDermott, Director of Engineering and External Affairs, presented the report.

6. TREASURER

Director Lo-Hill stated that the Treasurer's report was in order.

7. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

A Attendance at MWD Board and Committee Meetings

Consider the request from Director Lynda Lo-Hill that her attendance at MWD Board and Committee meetings be authorized as a day of service, which would qualify for per diem compensation and expense reimbursement.

General Manager David Pedersen presented the report.

<u>Director Caspary</u> moved to add attendance at MWD Board and/or Committee meetings as an authorized day of service, but identify which meetings Director Lo-Hill proposes to attend. Motion seconded by Director Renger.

Director Lo-Hill noted that she was attending one MWD Committee meeting day per month.

<u>Director Caspary</u> moved to amend his motion to specify that all five Directors may be reimbursed for up to a maximum of four MWD Board and/or committee meeting days per month. Amended motion seconded by <u>Director Renger</u>.

A discussion ensued regarding support and concerns with the motion.

<u>Director Caspary</u> moved to amend his motion to allow attendance at two MWD Board and/or Committee meetings per month by any of the five Directors, and once there are two such meeting days paid by the District, no other Director would be reimbursed that month.

General Manager David Pedersen suggested that attendance to MWD Board and/or Committee meetings would be effective immediately, and staff would bring back an amendment to the Las Virgenes Code to reflect the change.

The amended motion died for lack of a second.

<u>Director Caspary</u> moved to amend his motion such that all five Directors may be reimbursed for attendance at up to three MWD Board and/or Committee meetings days per month. Amended motion seconded by <u>Director Renger</u>.

Directors Caspary, Lo-Hill, Polan, and Renger were in favor. Board President Lewitt was opposed. Motion carried.

B Local Agency Formation Commission: Election of Special District Representative

Select a candidate to serve as the Local Agency Formation Commission Special District Representative, and authorize the General Manager to execute and return the official voting ballot no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 6, 2020.

General Manager David Pedersen presented the report.

<u>Director Caspary</u> moved to support Donald L. Dear as the Local Agency Formation Commission Special District Representative and approve Item 7B. Motion seconded by <u>Director Lo-Hill</u>. Motion carried unanimously.

8. FACILITIES AND OPERATIONS

A Award of Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Vehicle Replacement Program

Authorize the General Manager to issue purchase orders to Elk Grove Auto Group of Elk Grove, in the amount of \$142,610.26, for three Dodge Ram 1500 4x4 quad cab trucks and two Dodge Ram 1500 4x2 quad cab trucks, and Fritts Ford of Riverside, in the amount of \$28,936.20, for a Transit Connect 6-passenger van.

John Zhao, Director of Facilities and Operations, presented the report.

<u>Director Polan</u> moved to approve Item 8A and approve the list of surplus vehicles for auction. Motion seconded by <u>Director Caspary</u>.

A discussion ensued regarding maintenance costs for the vehicles listed on the surplus vehicles for auction list.

Motion carried unanimously.

B Infrastructure Investment Plan: Fiscal Years 2020-21 through 2029-30

Receive and file the LVMWD Infrastructure and Investment Plan for Fiscal Years 2020-21 through 2029-30.

Doug Anders, Administrative Services Coordinator, presented the report.

<u>Director Caspary</u> moved to approve Item 8B. Motion seconded by <u>Director Polan</u>.

Joe McDermott, Director of Engineering and External Affairs, responded to questions related to the estimated project costs for AMR Implementation Job No. 10660 and the testing program for the AMR/AMI meters.

Mr. Anders responded to a question regarding Potable Water System Rehabilitation Job No. 201847 related to budgeting for unexpected equipment maintenance and replacement expenses.

Darrell Johnson, Water Systems Manager, responded to a question regarding the 3-Inch and Larger Meter Replacements Job No. 201851 by stating that the estimated project costs would be in addition to the AMR/AMI Project.

Motion carried unanimously.

9. FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION

A Potable Water Standby Charge: Adoption of Ordinance

Waive the full reading of proposed Ordinance No. 282 as it relates to continuation of the Water Replacement Fund Standby Charge for Fiscal Year 2020-21; give second reading of the Ordinance by title only; pass, approve, and adopt the Ordinance as presented; and order publication within 15 days of adoption using a summary of the Ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. 282 (SECOND READING AND ADOPTION)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF LAS VIRGENES MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT AS IT RELATES TO STANDBY CHARGES FOR THE FISCAL EAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 2020.

(Reference is hereby made to Ordinance No. 282 on file in the District's Ordinance Book and by this reference the same is incorporated herein.)

Don Patterson, Director of Finance and Administration, presented the report.

<u>Director Caspary</u> moved to approve Item 9A. Motion seconded by <u>Director Renger</u>. Motion carried unanimously.

Keith Lemieux, District Counsel, read Ordinance No. 282 in title only.

B Selection of Bond Counsel for Potential Future Debt Issuance: Award

Authorize the General Manager to execute an initial five-year contract with Stradling Yocca Carlson & Rauth, in the amount of \$50,000, with optional extensions for up to five additional years, for bond counsel services.

Don Patterson, Director of Finance and Administration, presented the report.

<u>Director Caspary</u> moved to approve Item 9B. Motion seconded by <u>Director Lo-Hill</u>.

Mr. Patterson responded to a question regarding the \$50,000 cost for bond counsel services by stating that the estimated cost would be to assist in securing financing for the AMR/AMI Project and a portion of the Pure Water Project Las Virgenes-Triunfo. He noted that any future costs would be presented to the Board for approval.

Director Caspary inquired whether there might be a cost savings with sharing the same bond counsel as the Calleguas-Las Virgenes Public Financing Authority (PFA). Brian Forbath, representing Stradling Yocca Carlson & Rauth, responded that there would be a small cost savings. Mr. Patterson added that the District would also look at options to fund the Pure Water Project Las Virgenes-Triunfo outside of the PFA.

Director Caspary requested an analysis and discussion of debt issuance for the AMR/AMI Project as it might affect the future issuance for the Pure Water Project Las Virgenes-Triunfo.

Mr. Patterson responded to a question regarding the Las Virgenes-Triunfo Joint Powers Authority Board's future consideration of the pros and cons of financing the Pure Water Project Las Virgenes-Triunfo together or separately.

Motion carried unanimously.

C Reimbursement Resolution for AMR/AMI Project: Adoption

Pass, approve, and adopt proposed Resolution No. 2569, authorizing the reimbursement of funds utilized for the Automatic Meter Reading/Advanced Metering Infrastructure Project from debt proceeds.

Don Patterson, Director of Finance and Administration, presented the report.

<u>Director Lo-Hill</u> moved to approve Item 9C. Motion seconded by <u>Director Caspary</u>.

A discussion ensued regarding the use of revenue generated from wasteful water use penalties to offset the cost of the AMR/AMI Project, and the status of Integrated Regional Water Management Planning Proposition 1 grant funding.

Joe McDermott, Director of Engineering and External Affairs, responded to a question regarding reducing District-wide water consumption with the conversion to smart meters by stating that water consumption could be reduced by five to ten percent, which was based on what other agencies accomplished by converting from manual meter reading to smart meters. He noted that savings include leak detection and customers being more aware of their water usage. He stated that staff would provide additional details at a future Board meeting.

Director Caspary requested that staff provide information regarding the leak detection savings from the previous AMR system.

Motion carried unanimously.

10. INFORMATION ITEMS

A Adequacy and Capacity of Westlake Dam Spillway

John Zhao, Director of Facilities and Operations, responded to questions related to the spillway and survey monuments.

Director Caspary asked staff to consider adding monuments to the spillway structure at the exit so that annual survey data may be documented and to augment the monthly visual inspections.

11. NON-ACTION ITEMS

A Organization Reports

Director Caspary reported that he attended the Executive Committee meeting of the Santa Monica Bay Restoration Commission on January 16th where they discussed repurposing the Proposition 12 grant funding awarded to Paramount Ranch to Topanga Creek Projects because the Paramount Ranch project could not proceed due to fire damage; the Ballona Wetlands Land Trust litigation; and the environmental impact report for the Ballona Wetlands Project. He also noted that the Committee would discuss the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's five-year review of the Santa Monica Bay National Estuary Program performance at its meeting in February.

B Director's Reports on Outside Meetings

Director Renger reported that he attended the California Association of Sanitation Agencies (CASA) Winter Conference in Indian Wells. He asked staff to revisit the possibility of flooding at the Tapia Water Reclamation Facility following fire, major storm events and debris obstructing the bridge.

Board President Lewitt reported that he also attended the CASA Winter Conference, where he attended a session regarding mentoring. He suggested that the District might considering implementing a mentoring program. He noted that former LVMWD employee,

Jeff Reinhardt, served as the Master of Ceremonies for the luncheon recognizing outgoing Executive Director Bobbi Larson. He also recognized LVMWD staff Mike McNutt and Steven Baird for assisting CASA staff by taking photographs and video during the conference. He also reported that he attended the CASA Federal Legislative Committee meeting in preparation for the upcoming CASA Washington D.C. Conference.

Director Polan reported that he attended the Association of Water Agencies of Ventura County WaterWise Breakfast on January 16th, where an update was provided by the NOAA/National Weather Service.

Director Caspary reported that he attended the ACWA State Legislative Committee meeting on January 24th, where they discussed recommended changes to several bills. He noted that a bill was introduced that proposes to mandate that community colleges develop curriculum for naturalists, and the committee was taking a favor if amended position due to the lack of labor classifications for naturalists in the Bureau of Labor Statistics. He noted that public comments for the Governor's Draft Water Resilience Portfolio would be due by February 7th. He also mentioned that a shuttle bus was available from the Sacramento International Airport to downtown Sacramento, which provides very low fares compared to other modes of transportation.

Director Lo-Hill reported that she attended the MWD Committee meetings, where they discussed conducting an emergency response practice exercise and drill. She also reported that she attended the CASA Winter Conference, where she attended a session regarding new technologies for the use of methane waste and solid oxide fuel cells for energy storage.

C General Manager Reports

(1) General Business

General Manager David Pedersen acknowledged District staff who were involved in responding to the Willow Incident. He also recognized Doug Anders and staff for their efforts on the Infrastructure Investment Plan, and Mike McNutt and Steven Baird for assisting CASA staff with communications during the CASA Winter Conference.

(2) Follow-Up Items

General Manager David Pedersen noted that a list of Board meeting follow-up items was provided to the Board.

D Directors' Comments

Director Polan noted that he forwarded an article to General Manager David Pedersen regarding the Delta-Mendota Canal, California Aqueduct, subsidence and cracks.

Director Lo-Hill asked everyone to be mindful of their health and safety in light of the coronavirus.

Board President Lewitt stated that he noticed very green grass at the Sherwood Country Club, which was likely due to the use of fertilizer. He stated that he spoke with John Zhao, Director of Facilities and Operations, regarding the concept of using drones to view customers' lawn areas. He noted that this was the time of year that grass goes dormant, and he suggested that the District promote encouraging customers to allow their lawns to go dormant in the winter.

12. FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS

None.

13. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Michael Omary, representing APD Clean Water Technologies Group, provided information regarding smart water ions filtration, PFAS, water treatment and testing. Director Lo-Hill expressed an interest in receiving a one or two-page summary of these technologies.

14. CLOSED SESSION

None.

15. OPEN SESSION AND ADJOURNMENT

Seeing no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was duly adjourned at 11:07 a.m.

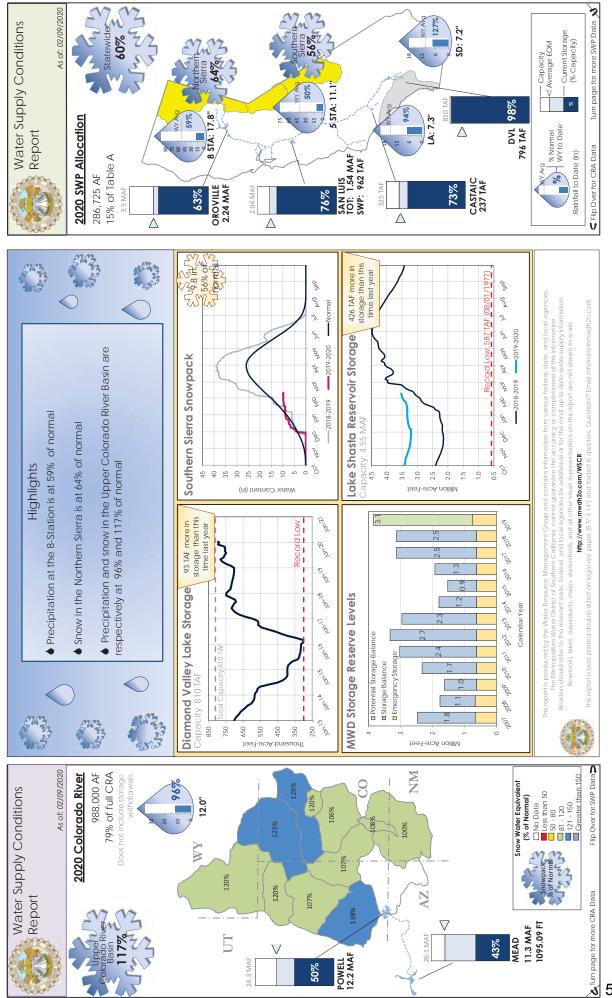

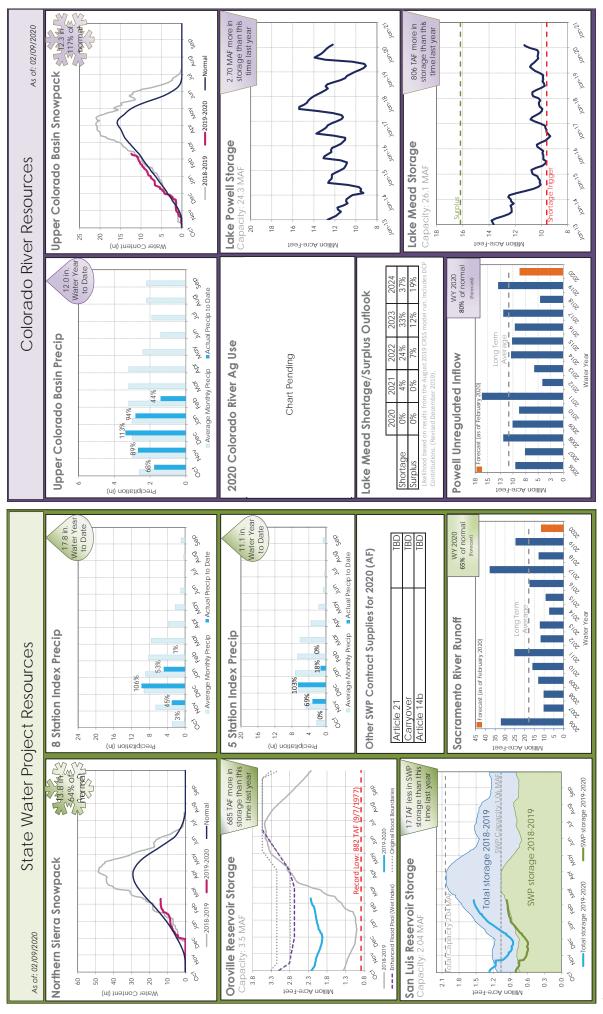

Order

The Las Virgenes-Triunfo Joint Powers Authority (JPA) approved funding for this matter in the JPA Budget. This recommendation is before the LVMWD Board, acting as Administering Agent of the JPA, as authorized in the JPA Agreement.

SUMMARY:

The Woolsey Fire burned 66% of the District's service area beginning on November 9, 2018, damaging many key facilities including the Rancho Las Virgenes Composting Facility. By the end of Fiscal Year 2018-19, the District recovered all operations with the exception of those at Rancho where dewatered biosolids continue to be hauled. The District continues the recovery effort and is seeking reimbursement for fire-related damages through its insurance carrier, the Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). As part of the process, staff solicited repair proposals for Rancho from companies with existing construction contracts for work at the facility: GSE Construction, Inc. (Digester No. 2 Rehabilitation Project) and Pacific Hydrotech Corporation (Amendment Bin and Conveyance System Modification Project). Staff recommends issuing a change order to GSE Construction, Inc., for repairs to the biofilter.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Authorize the General Manager to execute Change Order No. 1 to GSE Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$188,100, to include repair of the biofilter at the Rancho Las Virgenes Composting Facility as part of the Digester No. 2 Rehabilitation Project.

FISCAL IMPACT:

No

ITEM BUDGETED:

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The cost of the work is \$188,100. Sufficient funding for the work is available in the adopted Fiscal Year 2019-20 JPA Budget. The expense is eligible for reimbursement through the District's insurance carrier.

DISCUSSION:

As of November 9, 2018, the Rancho Las Virgenes Composting Facility has been out of service due to the damages that occurred during the Woolsey Fire. Staff have been working with CalOES, FEMA and the District's insurance carrier to secure reimbursement for the cost of repairs to the facility. To expedite the completion of repairs and restore the operation of Rancho, staff determined that the best strategy is to issue change orders to two companies that currently hold construction contracts with the District for work at the facility: Pacific Hydrotech Corporation and GSE Construction, Inc.

The two contractors were provided the same scope of work, which included repair of the biofilter together with structural and mechanical repairs to the Amendment Building. Legal Counsel advised staff to ensure that the work for any proposed change orders is related to the original scope of work described in the construction contract. The work being performed by GSE Construction for the Digester No. 2 Rehabilitation Project is most closely related to the proposed biofilter repairs, while Pacific Hydrotech's work for Amendment Bin and Conveyance System Modifications Project is most closely related to the required structural and mechanical repairs within the Amendment Building.

Staff proposes to complete the repairs at Rancho in two phases as additional funding is approved by the District's insurance carrier. Phase I will consist of repairing the biofilter, as it provides odor control for the composting process. Once the biofilter is repaired, staff can manually load amendment to allow for the composting process to be restarted. While this will temporary process will produce a lower yield of compost, the product can be provided again to the public by late summer 2020. Staff recommends that Change Order No. 1, in the amount of \$188,100, be issued to GSE Construction for the Digester No. 2 Rehabilitation Project. The change order would constitute a 9.9% increase to the current contract amount. The LVMWD Code establishes that a single change order that amounts to 5% or more of the original contract amount must be approved by the Board. The scope of work consists of installing the recently purchased baseplates and trench covers, repairing the irrigation system and replacing the biofilter media. Completion of the Phase I work will allow for the composting operation to be restored with limited capacity.

Phase II will include the necessary structural and mechanical repairs within the Amendment Building. The work consists of structural repairs to the Amendment Building, replacement of the dust collector and other mechanical equipment repairs. This work will eliminate the need for staff to manually load amendment, resulting in a greater compost yield and restoring Rancho to its full pre-Woolsey Fire operational capacity. Staff will recommend a change order to Pacific Hydrotech Corporation to complete the Phase II repairs at a future meeting once additional reimbursement is secured and costs are confirmed.

SUMMARY:

On April 29, 2019, the Board authorized the General Manager to execute a one-year professional services agreement with The Pun Group, in the amount of \$40,000, with four one-year renewal options using a 3% annual escalator, to provide independent audit services. Staff recommends accepting the first one-year renewal option.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Authorize the General Manager to execute the first one-year renewal option with The Pun Group, in the amount of \$41,200, to provide independent audit services.

FISCAL IMPACT:

ITEM BUDGETED:

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The cost of this action is \$41,200, which constitutes a 3% annual increase. Sufficient funds are available for the service in the adopted budget Fiscal Year 2019-20 Budget.

DISCUSSION:

The Pun Group was selected through a competitive process that included interviews by the District's Audit Committee comprised of the Board President and Treasurer. The firm presented a comprehensive approach to audit services, demonstrated thorough knowledge of current and upcoming Government Accounting Standards Board (GASB) requirements, and

proposed a team with a track record of successfully performing government agency audits.

The Pun Group completed the Fiscal Year 2018-19 audits in compliance with the contract and auditing standards. Staff recommends that the Board authorize the General Manager to execute the first of four potential one-year renewal options, in the amount of \$41,200, which is based on a 3% escalation factor.

Subject: Update on Weather Based Irrigation Controller Give-Away Program

SUMMARY:

On October 23, 2018, the Board accepted a proposal from Rachio, Inc., to implement a Weather Based Irrigation Controller Give-Away Program in partnership with the District. The program consisted of providing 2,000 irrigation controllers to customers over a two-year period with an emphasis on those with wasteful water use. To date, 1,612 controllers have been installed for customers. A preliminary evaluation of the program's effectiveness shows positive results with reductions in the number of customers exceeding 200% of their budgets and total water use in excess of budget. Staff and Rachio representatives will provide an update on the program including a review of customer satisfaction and a preliminary evaluation of effectiveness. Also, staff will review alternatives for potential changes to the program.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Consider the effectiveness of the Weather Based Irrigation Controller Give-Away Program and provide feedback on alternatives for potential changes to the program.

FISCAL IMPACT:

ITEM BUDGETED:

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

There is no financial impact associated with this action.

DISCUSSION:

Background:

The Weather Based Irrigation Controller Give-Away Program was initiated in late February 2019 with the first controllers installed in early March of that year. Customer response was immediate with 120 controllers installed in the first month of the program. Interest in the program remained strong through the summer and fall with an anticipated slowdown during the winter months. Despite the anticipated slowdown, 1,612 controllers have been installed as of February 4, 2020, well ahead of the goal to install 2,000 controllers over a two-year period.

While the program was primarily intended to address wasteful water use, there was a desire by the Board to provide an opportunity for efficient and inefficient customers to participate in the program as well, although to a lesser degree. As a result, the program was structured to provide 80% of controllers to wasteful water use customers and the remaining 20% to efficient and inefficient customers. To maximize the distribution of controllers to wasteful water use customers, a very effective email campaign was implemented and targeted only to wasteful water use customers. The approach has resulted in a controller distribution of 82% to wasteful water use customers and 18% to efficient and inefficient water use customer. Program participation by efficient and inefficient customers has been solely the result of customers becoming aware of the program by word of mouth and neighbor-to-neighbor discussions.

Customer Feedback:

Customer surveys were sent to participants approximately two weeks after installation to evaluate satisfaction and address any issues or concerns. Despite some issues during the early implementation of the program and isolated customer issues over the period of implementation, customer satisfaction with both the program and product has been extremely high. Results from the customer surveys will be presented using an evaluation tool called the "Net Promoter Score" that is used to evaluate customer satisfaction.

Program Effectiveness:

Staff and representatives from Rachio will also present preliminary information on program effectiveness. Year-to-year comparisons of program effectiveness are difficult to draw concrete conclusions from, particularly for programs such as this one that have multiple variables affecting the results. Variables such as the date of controller installation, changing evapotranspiration rates, water budgets and artifacts associated with program implementation such as how the target email lists were developed could all have different and independent effects on the program results. However, early indications show positive results for both water savings and effectiveness in moving wasteful water use customers closer to their water budgets. Estimated water savings in 2020 from full implementation of the program results in an estimated range of water savings between 178 acre-feet per year to 270 acre-feet per year. This range of water savings corresponds to a 3.0 to 4.8 year return on investment (ROI) for the program. Additionally, when framed in the context of an estimated 15-year lifespan of the installed controllers, water savings could range from 2,670 to 4,050 acre-feet.

Alternatives for Future Changes to Program:

Finally, staff is considering alternatives for potential future changes to program. The following alternatives are being considered: (1) status quo – no change to the existing program; (2) level rebate subsidy for all customers – augment existing Metropolitan rebates with a pre-

determined amount that is available to all customers; and (3) hybrid program – maintain current program for high water use customers but provide a cost-sharing option that is open to all other customers. Based upon feedback provided by the Board on these alternatives, a recommendation for any proposed changes to the program will be presented at a future meeting.
