MINUTES REGULAR MEETING

5:00 PM July 10, 2012

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

At the request of President Renger, the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was led by Director Peterson.

1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

A Call to order and roll call

The meeting was called to order at 5:02 p.m. by President Renger in the District offices. Assistant Deputy Secretary Conklin called the roll. Those answering present were Directors Bowman, Caspary, Peterson, Renger and Steinhardt.

2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

A Approval of agenda

General Manager Mundy requested "9A: Commercial Paper and Medium Term Notes" be heard after "4B: Legislative and Regulatory Updates".

On a motion by Director Charles Caspary, seconded by Director Barry Steinhardt, the Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Approve the Regular Board Meeting of July 10, 2012, as amended by the recommendation of General Manager Mundy.

3. PUBLIC COMMENTS

No speaker cards were received from the public.

4. ILLUSTRATIVE AND/OR VERBAL PRESENTATION AGENDA ITEMS

A Clover Trail Main Extension Refund Agreeement

Direct staff on which option to implement.

ITEM 5A

Director of Facilities and Operations Lippman stated the Board had approved the Clover Trail Main Extension on March 27, 2012, and discussed options for payment(s) and payment plans as requested by customers.

Board questions and comments included: were limited service holders notified (Mr. Lippman responded yes, that all were notified and there is a process in place for when properties change ownership); and a clause for debtors to pay all costs (Legal Counsel Lemieux stated Las Virgenes had the right to place a lien on the property for limited service costs, which would be payable prior to the mortgage lien).

On a motion by Director Joseph Bowman, seconded by Director Barry Steinhardt, the Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Approve the staff recommendation of a 6-month payment plan with a first payment due date of September 15, 2012; and as part of the installment plan, if a payment is missed then the full amount becomes due and payable; principal balance plus interest at legal prevailing rate, Los Angeles County-State of California; and reimbursement of any and all costs including collection fees incurred by Las Virgenes.

B Legislative and Regulatory Updates

No report was given by staff.

Director Peterson commented on AB 17 (Davis), which would modify the existing "taking office" dates (Legal Counsel Lemieux stated the Assembly Bill has no effect on Las Virgenes and was related to Central Basin Municipal Water District elections only).

At this point in the meeting "9A: Commercial Paper and Medium Term Notes" was heard.

5. CONSENT CALENDAR

On a motion by Director Glen Peterson, seconded by Director Charles Caspary, the Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Approve Consent Calendar 5A-5C as presented in the recommendations.

6. TREASURER

Treasurer Steinhardt stated the accounts payable checks were in order and kudos to staff for paying an invoice prior to the due date that allowed for a discounted amount to be paid.

7. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

A State Filings: Secretary of State "Statement of Facts - Roster of Public Agencies Filing" and Fair Political Practices Commission CA Form 806 "Agency Report of: Public Official Appointments"

District Counsel to discuss state required filings.

Legal Counsel Lemieux discussed the State of California - Secretary of State "Statement of

Facts Roster of Public Agencies Filing" and its importance to the claim process; and Fair Political Practices Commission Form 806 "Agency Report of Public Official Appointments", which is an income/per diem related appointment filing.

8. FACILITIES AND OPERATIONS

A Award of Annual Contracts - AECOM and MSO

Approve the annual contracts with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. and MSO Technologies, Inc. for FY2012-2013.

Board comments included: the engineering services should be shopped around instead of awarding to AECOM (Director of Facilities and Operations Lippman noted AECOM's quick turnaround time and work is performed as needed with many engineering services going out for bid); wealth of knowledge and agency history as AECOM (formerly Boyle) has consulted since the District was formed; wants Water System Design Reports to be consistent, and the District's staff hasn't had an increase in the last three years - AECOM has had a 5% increase in two years.

On a motion by Director Glen Peterson, seconded by Director Lee Renger, the Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Approve the recommendations as presented. The Board also directed staff to notify AECOM of their dissatisfaction with the rate increases the last two years of 3% and 2% respectively.

B Building #1 Improvements

Provide further direction to staff.

On a motion by Director Joseph Bowman, seconded by Director Glen Peterson, the Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Authorize staff to proceed with Option 2 (provide an elevator, parking and circulation improvements for a total of \$208,200 with no interior improvements except general cleanup until space(s) are rented).

AYES: Director(s) Bowman, Caspary, Peterson, Renger, Steinhardt

C Carbon Tower Carbon Replacement: Authorization of Purchase Orders

Waive the formal bidding process; authorize the General Manager to issue a purchase order in an amount of \$43,462 to Carbon Activated Corporation for carbon tower media replacement at the Tapia WRF; and authorize the General Manager to issue a purchase order in an amount of \$2,473 to Carbon Activated Corporation for carbon tower media replacement at the lift stations.

Board inquired as to why waiving of bids was requested (Director of Facilities and Operations Lippman stated there were only a few vendors who provide the product, so a quote process is utilized).

On a motion by Director Lee Renger, seconded by Director Glen Peterson, the Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Approve the recommendations as presented.

D Compost Reactor Building Ceiling Repair - Final Acceptance

Approve a time extension of 61 calendar days to complete the project; approve the final Progress Payment, in the amount of \$2,000.00 to Ventura Construction, Inc.; approve the execution of a Notice of Completion by the Secretary of the Board for and on behalf of the District and have the same recorded; and that in the absence of claims from subcontractors and others, release retention in the amount of \$33,444.87 thirty calendar days after the final progression.

Notice of Completion for the Compost Building Ceiling Repair Project.

Board questioned if the Joint Powers Authority (JPA) Board was approving project acceptance (Director of Facilities and Operations Lippman stated "no" as the project budget was determined by an engineering estimate and no additional appropriation was needed, and General Manager Mundy noted the Las Virgenes Board in accordance with the JPA agreement was authorized to approve the project acceptance and that Triunfo would be notified by an Information Only memo).

On a motion by Director Glen Peterson, seconded by Director Charles Caspary, the Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Approve the recommendations as presented.

9. FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION

A Commercial Paper and Medium Term Notes

Approve adding commercial paper and medium term notes as authorized investments and direct District Counsel to prepare a resolution to that end.

Finance Manager Lillio stated William Blackwill, Director of Institutional Client Group with Citigroup Global Markets Inc. would be discussing the pros and cons of commercial paper and medium term notes; and recommended modification to investment policies and or the Las Virgenes Administrative Code authorizing such investments.

Mr. Blackwill discussed pros and cons, interest income, drawbacks include the substantial amount of monitoring needed for these investment types, Local Agency Investment Fund (LAIF) is serving the District well, authorizing these investment types does allow for additional flexibility, Government Code Section 53601 restricts agency investments, and commercial paper is not very viable right now.

Board comments included: the Board can change the investment policy at any time, and doesn't believe this is a good time to change the investment policy unless strict limitations were in place.

No action was taken pertaining to Commercial Paper and Medium Term Notes.

B Prepayment of PERS Fiscal Year 2012/13 Expense (Not OPEB)

Authorize prepayment of the PERS expense for Fiscal Year 2012/13, to be paid between July 1 and July 15, 2012.

On a motion by Director Lee Renger, seconded by Director Barry Steinhardt, the Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Approve the recommendation as presented (the pre-payment of 2012-2013 Employer Contribution is based on the June 30, 2010 actuarial valuation report and is in the amount of \$1,824,734).

Subject: Joint Powers Insurance Authority (JPIA) Board of Directors Representatives

SUMMARY:

On July 16, 2012, the General Manager received correspondence from the Association of California Water Agencies/Joint Powers Insurance Authority (ACWA/JPIA "Authority") requesting a JPIA Director Representative and a JPIA Alternate Representative be appointed to serve on the JPIA Board of Directors as required by Article 7 of the JPIA Agreement. Directors and Alternates serve until a successor is appointed by the Member (Las Virgenes Municipal Water District).

The JPIA Director Representative must be a member of the agency's board of directors. The JPIA Alternate Representative shall be an officer, member of the governing board, or an employee of the Member.

Within 30-days of appointment, the JPIA Director Representative must file with JPIA an original Form 700 as required by the Fair Political Practices Commission. The JPIA Alternate Representative is not required to file a Form 700.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

The Board of Directors to appoint one member of the board of directors to serve as the District's JPIA Director Representative; and appoint one officer, member of the governing board, or employee of the District to serve as the JPIA Alternate Representative.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

None at this time, but there will be associated travel expenses, twice per year for the JPIA Director Representative and/or JPIA Alternate Representative.

On July 1, 2012, the ACWA Health Benefits Authority transitioned its Employee Benefits programs to the JPIA. The programs and coverages you enjoyed though the HBA are still the same now that they are part of the JPIA. You are also now members of the JPIA. The JPIA was formed in 1979 as a means to consistently and cost effectively providing the broadest possible insurance coverages to its member agencies.

While Members of the JPIA may participate in one, two, three, or all four of its Programs, they all have the same thing in common. They all have a representative (JPIA Director) on the JPIA's Board of Directors.

Article 7 of the JPIA's Agreement addresses the JPIA's Board of Directors. In part, it states that the Authority (ACWA/JPIA) shall be governed by the Board of Directors which is composed of one representative from each Member, who shall be a **member director selected by the governing board of that Member**. Each Member, in addition to appointing its member of the Board, shall appoint at least one Alternate who shall be an officer, member of the governing board, or employee of that Member. The Directors and Alternates serve until a successor is appointed and at the pleasure of the Member by which he or she has been appointed. Each Director representing a Member, or his or her Alternate, shall have one vote.

The JPIA Board of Directors' meetings are held twice a year, during the spring and fall ACWA Conferences. While the Directors and/or their Alternates are encouraged to attend these Board meetings, the JPIA understands that it is not always possible. Expenses, per diem, and fees incurred by the Directors and Alternates to attend the Board meetings and the ACWA conferences are the responsibility of their respective districts.

At your earliest convenience, please complete and return the attached form with the Director's and Alternate's names, titles, mailing addresses, and email addresses so that we may update our data base.

Subject: Labor Relations Negotiator

SUMMARY:

As provided for in the Office and General Unit's Memorandum of Understandings (MOUs), SEIU Local 721, ARTICLE 3 - RENEGOTIATIONS, Section 3.2.b states:

3.2 In-term Openers:

b. During 2012 and 2014, either Party may require negotiations concerning one topic. To initiate negotiations, a written request to commence negotiations as well as the written proposal concerning the topic chosen shall be submitted during the month of August. Negotiations shall begin thereafter within, but no later than, thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of the aforementioned notice and proposal. The other Party may also select one topic for negotiations and notice of such topic with a written proposal concerning such topic shall be submitted at the first negotiations meeting.

Since the Board has asked the General Manager to develop and submit re-opener "Topics" for consideration and presentation in August and with the General Manger's pending retirement in December of this year, it is recommended the Board hire and designate an outside labor relations negotiator.

This recommendation is presented in order to afford the Board an opportunity to retain a negotiator who can provide a historical context and continuity in employee negotiations over the next two years. With the Management and Supervisor, Professional and Confidential MOUs expiring on June 30, 2013 and the Office and General Unit's MOUs expiring December 31, 2014 it is important to consider bringing in a designated negotiator, during this re-opener period, who can provide context in future negotiations.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Designate Peter Brown, with the firm Liebert Cassidy Whitmore, as Labor Relations Negotiator.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Funds for a labor negotiator are budgeted and available in 701430.6522. The hourly rate for Mr. Brown is \$270. The total cost is to be determined.

DISCUSSION:

Representative Matters

Appellate:

Williams v. Chino Valley Fire District (2011) - A disability retired fire captain contended that he was entitled to his job back after he over-came his disabilities. LCW attorneys argued that as a retiree, he was not entitled to his job back. The San Bernardino Superior Court disagreed and ordered that he be given the first available Fire Captain position. The LCW attorneys brought a writ to the California Court of Appeal and the Court of Appeal reversed the Superior Court, issuing the writ and agreeing with their argument that the law did not entitle Mr. Williams to a job with the fire district. The Supreme Court also denied review on June 8, 2011.

Negotiations:

City of Santa Ana Police, Fire and General Employee Negotiations (2011-2012) - As the Chief Negotiator for the City of Santa Ana, Brown recently was tasked with helping the City who was faced with a \$30 million budget deficit. Tustin, like many California cities continues to receive significant increases to their pension costs and these goals of the negotiations process were realized.

Long Beach Community College District – Faculty Negotiations (2011) - As the Chief Negotiator, Brown was able to negotiate an agreement with the faculty in a way that saved the District hundreds of thousands of dollars while having minimal impact on the faculty. Primarily, modifications were made to health insurance options in a creative manner acceptable to the faculty and the Board of Trustees.

City of Claremont – four employee associations (2011) - Mr. Brown served as the Chief negotiator for the City of Claremont reaching agreements with all four of their non-safety employee associations which included pension concessions to address pension costs which added to the City's budget issues. The concessions require the employees to pay all of the employee contributions over a three year period. The agreements also brought labor peace and stability to the City.

Ventura Regional Sanitation District – Two employee associations (2011) - Mr. Brown successfully negotiated collective bargaining agreements with both the SEIU and IUOE bargaining units resulting in

Subject: 2012 Las Virgenes Dam - Settlement Report

SUMMARY:

On May 1, 2012, Benner and Carpenter Land Surveyors surveyed at the Las Virgenes Dam to assess recent settlement. The Las Virgenes Dam Settlement Report has been developed from this survey. Previous surveys were performed by Benner and Carpenter Land Surveyors and Peak Surveys, Inc. Survey results from both surveyors are deemed to be consistent. This report addresses the movement of monuments located on the crest of the dam and in the spillway. Additionally, seepage flow, rainfall amounts and reservoir level measurements are analyzed in the report in a format recommended by the Department of Water Resources, Division of Safety of Dams (DSOD). This report took into consideration seepage measurements taken from the District's automated monitoring facilities.

DSOD has requested that seepage flow, reservoir level and horizontal and vertical movement of monuments located on the crest of the Las Virgenes Dam be monitored and reported. The California Water Code authorizes DSOD to issue rules and regulations to safeguard life and property regarding dams. The last inspection performed by the DSOD occurred in the Spring 2011, with no significant comments. In the case of an earthquake of magnitude 5.0 or greater in the vicinity of the dam, the District is required to perform additional surveys. There have been no earthquakes of magnitude 5.0 or greater within the vicinity of the dam since the last survey performed on January 18, 2011.

The results of the survey show no significant variances from the measurements of past years, indicating that further investigation of the dam is not necessary until the next settlement survey tentatively scheduled for January 2013.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Receive and file the Las Virgenes Dam Settlement Report No. 2498.00

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

There is no financial impact associated with this action.

Subject: Air Conditioning Controls Upgrade for Headquarters Campus Buildings #7 & #8

SUMMARY:

Recently building number eight and building number seven have experienced failures with their respective HVAC (heating, ventilation, and air conditioning) control systems. The systems are approaching twenty years and many items within the systems are no longer supported by the manufacturer resulting in costly repairs and lengthy system outages. The main source of failure in building eight is the main brain or TSM (Terminal System Manager). The TSM is the main air handling and system balancing controller for the building. The TSM has been deemed obsolete per Carrier Controls Service Bulletin #C0703 (see attached). With the lack of manufacture's support and the recent failures in building number eight's sophisticated variable air volume controls a major control system upgrade is needed to restore functionality and will enable the latest energy saving techniques. Building seven has older pneumatic technology which also cannot take advantage of these energy saving schemes estimated to save up to 45% of current usage for that building. These non-proprietary upgrades will allow maximum energy savings to be realized.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Authorize the General Manager to approve the upgrade to the HVAC system on building eight and building seven and award the contract to West Coast Power Solutions.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Funding for this expenditure was approved as part of the Fiscal Year 2012-13 budget in accounts 10531.1880.505 and 701002.5530.

PURPOSE:

To inform the field of the obsolescence of several PSIO II control boards and communication CIO modules. The PSIO II Remanufactured Program is being set up to preserve and extend the life of the equipment on which these modules are used. Once the supply of new modules has been depleted, only a remanufactured module will be available. It is very important to return all failed control modules to RCD for remanufacturing.

INFORMATION:

Due to the obsolescence of several electronic components a limited number of new PSIO II and 8088 processor based CIO modules can be produced.

RCD has begun a PIC Control Board Remanufacturing Program for the support of those modules. This program is being set up to preserve and extend the life of the equipment on which these modules are used. The machine models affected are 17, 19, 23, 30, 38, 39, 48 and 50 series with PSIO II and communication CIO modules.

This program applies to the current part numbers listed in the table on page 2 of this bulletin <u>or any prior part number for a PSIO II module not listed</u>. Any other style module returned to RCD is not eligible for a core credit and should be scrapped.

All core exchanges returned in support of the PIC Control Board Remanufacturing Program will be credited via the standard parts Return Material process. All modules returned off the open market for a core exchange credit when a replacement module is not ordered from RCD will only receive a "dead body" credit allowance. Contact RCD if you need more information or have any questions.

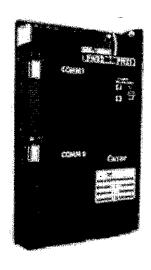

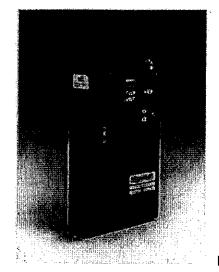

Subject: Building #1 Improvements

SUMMARY:

On June 12, 20102, staff informed the Board that structural improvements were made to Building 1 shortly after the 1994 Northridge Earthquake and the estimated total improvement costs for Building 1 interior and parking is \$496,700 with a payback period of 4-5 years based on lease rates of \$2.25 to \$2.75/SF. The Board directed staff to determine if additional tenant improvement allowance would be an alternative to the proposed interior improvements. Based on the directions, staff provided a technical memorandum on July 10, 2012 with an analysis of two options: Option 1 is to provide interior improvements, parking and circulation improvements for a total of \$496,700 with a payback period of 2.6 to 5.5 years based on lease rate of \$1.90/SF to \$1.15 SF. Option 2 is to provide an elevator, parking and circulation improvements for a total of \$208,200 with no interior improvement. A higher tenant improvement allowance would be provided that may range from \$419,482 (\$31.73/SF) to \$465,198 (\$35.19/SF) that would also provide a similar payback period of 2.6 to 5.5 years based on lease rates of \$1.15/SF to \$1.90/SF. The Board directed staff to pursue an architect and engineering proposal in line with option 2 and clean up the interior of the building to make it more marketable.

Staff solicited a proposal from Eric Rohlfing, Architect (also known as ENRdesign) to provide Architectural, Structural and Electrical construction drawings and specifications to install a new elevator, add a circular driveway around the building and establish additional parkings, a monument sign and landscape lighting and controls. The total cost is \$25.750.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve the proposal from Eric Rohlfing (also known as ENRdesign) for a total amount of \$25,750 to provide Architectural, Structural and Electrical construction drawings and specifications to install a new elevator, add a circular driveway around the building and establish additional parkings, a monument sign and landscape lighting and controls.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The proposed improvements will be funded through CIP Work Order Account 10463 which has an approved budget of \$150,000 for FY 12-13.

<u>Architectural Services – Eric N. Rohlfing (ENRdesign Architects)</u>

A revised proposal for drawings and specifications, which takes into account the limited scope and the required sub consultants to design the new elevator installation, rebuild the north vehicle access one-way loop, add a new ADA wheelchair ramp at the west entrance as required, revise the west parking into 90 degree parking with two-way access, add new south 90 degree parking, install a new monument sign, and add necessary landscape lighting & controls.

The proposed fee includes the work provided by the engineering sub consultants of Eric N. Rohlfing, Architect as follows:

<u>Structural Engineering (SE) – David Reith & Associates (DRA), Simi Valley, CA</u> DRA will provide the structural design, documents, calculations and specifications for the elevator installation and landscape improvements.

Electrical Engineering (EE) - C. Hood & Associates (CH)

CH will provide the electrical construction documents, calculations and specifications for the installation of the new elevator, and the proposed site lighting improvements.

<u>Note</u>: If an existing soil report is unavailable, or deemed invalid, a geotechnical engineer may be needed to generate a new soil report (see exclusions).



Exclusions

- Repartitioning spaces for tenants or providing new common/egress space.
- Fire alarm system, security/data/audio systems and energy compliance reports.
- Modifications to HVAC system
- Structural & Electrical observation site visits
- Other consultants, including geotechnical, survey, mechanical, etc.

DESIGN SERVICES

CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENT SERVICES (CD)

The Construction Document Services include:

- Development of the appearance, performance, structure and details of the design through computer model, plan, elevation and section drawings.
- Integration of the various building systems, such as structural, electrical, etc.
- Coordination with the Client's consultants.
- Production of original construction documents and specifications (plans, or blueprints).
- Assistance with the selection of systems, equipment, fixtures, components, cabinetry, materials, finishes and colors.
- Calculations, as required for permit, including structural and electrical.
- Updates to the project budget and construction estimate.
- Creation and maintenance of a Client web page to facilitate the exchange of plans and information.
- Assistance with obtaining planning approvals and building permits.

Construction Monitoring Services include:

- Regular architectural observation of construction progress on-site to assure that the project is built according to the design intent, budget and schedule. Additional fees will apply to other consultants, such as structural and electrical.
- Communication of observations and recommendations by meeting, letter, phone or email to the Client and Building Contractor.
- Assistance to the Building Contractor with interpretation of the construction documents and design intent.
- Supplemental details & sketches, as required.
- Assistance to Client with reconciling the Building Contractor payment requests with the actual work progress & quality.

- Verification of completion.



ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Any additional work will be handled on an hourly basis at \$75/hr. (Architect) plus reimbursable expenses. These services may include:

- Special zoning applications (variance application, planning commission presentations, Coastal Commission application).
- Re-design to meet the requests of applicable design review boards.
- Follow-up response presentations to design review boards.
- Work related to significant adjustments to the scope of work, such as structural changes, or added square footage, per the Design Program (Design Goals).
- Production of record drawings. These are post-construction drawings updated to include pertinent revisions that occurred during construction.
- Post-occupancy services, such as warranty evaluations.
- Environmental design certification.
- Design of furnishings and/or treatments (furniture design/selection, window/wall coverings).
- Additional services of other consultants (structural, electrical) will be billed at their hourly rate, as needed.

REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES

A 10% charge is added to reimbursable expenses. Reimbursable items include:

- Contracting service of additional consultants (surveyor, civil engineer, geotechnical engineer, arborist, etc.) on behalf of the Client
- Consulting engineering (structural, electrical) observation site visits, as required by Building Department
- Reproduction (photos, blueprints, etc.)
- Express mail/delivery service

Other reimbursable expenses include:

- Automobile mileage beyond a 25 mile radius from Project at \$0.40 per mile.

The Client shall furnish the services of other consultants, such as structural, mechanical, electrical & civil engineers, energy efficiency analysts, security consultants, audio-visual consultants and fire sprinkler system designers, as are reasonably required by the scope of the Project, unless the services for these consultants are expressly included elsewhere in this Agreement.

The Client shall furnish structural, mechanical, and chemical tests; tests for air and water pollution; tests for hazardous materials; and other laboratory and environmental tests, inspections and reports as required by law or the Contract Documents.

The Client may request that the Architect contract for any of the above services directly, as a convenience for the Client.

Subject: Tapia Influent Pipeline and Valve Replacement Project - Ratification of Change Order No. 2

Las Virgenes-Triunfo Joint Powers Authority approved funding for this matter in the Joint Powers Authority Budget. This recommendation is before the LVMWD Board of Directors for action, as administering agent, as authorized under the Joint Powers Authority Agreement.

SUMMARY:

The 20" and 24" influent force mains transport raw sewage from Tapia's influent pump station to the primary clarifier tanks. Several failures of these steel pipelines and the inoperability of valves within the pump station necessitated their replacement. On January 9, 2012, the Board awarded the contract to perform the required maintenance to GSE Construction.

Change Order No. 2 includes the replacement and relocation of an existing pipe supports in the influent pump station; the addition of two victualic joints to facilitate installation of the new 20-inch pipe; and maintenance by the contractor on an existing 24-inch gate valve. Modifications were made to the pipe supports because the new pipe has a slightly larger outside diameter than the existing force main. District staff also determined that it would be more efficient to have the contractor perform the maintenance on the existing 24-inch valve in order to have it immediately available for operation. Change Order No. 2 was administratively approved by the general manager in the amount of \$11,028.00 and is being brought before the Board for ratification. Previously, Change Order No. 1 was ratified by the Board at the June 26, 2012 meeting in the amount of \$25,580.00. Change Order No. 1 included the replacement of an existing 20-inch valve in the influent pump station.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Ratify Change Order No. 2 in the amount of \$11,028.00; \$5,367.00 attributed to the Tapia Influent Pipeline & Valve Replacement Project; \$5,661.00 attributed to the Tapia Influent Pipeline Rehabilitation Project.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Change Order No.2 increases the Tapia Influent Pipeline and Valve Replacement Project total contract amount to \$266,186.00. These improvements will be funded through CIP Work Order Account 10462. The total contract amount for the Tapia Influent Pipeline Rehabilitation Project increases to \$463,511.00. No appropriations are required.

DISCUSSION:

The replacement of pipeline supports, and the maintenance of the existing 24-inch associated with Change Order No. 2 are part of the work for the Tapia Influent Pipeline and Replacement Project. The cost associated with these two items is \$5,367.00. The cost for the addition of two victaulic joints in the amount of \$5,661.00 is part of the work associated with the Tapia Influent Pipeline Rehabilitation Project. Both projects are funded through CIP Work Order 10462 and are being constructed concurrently.

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
