Subject: General Liability and Property Insurance Renewal

SUMMARY:

The District's general liability and property insurance comes up for annual renewal on October 1. The District's insurance broker has reviewed the proposal from the current insurers and a new program available through Alteris Insurance that may be more suited to the District's needs.

Staff has reviewed the proposals with the insurance broker. Staff has been happy with Glatfelters Insurance, the main insurance carrier, which has provided excellent service and coverage to the District. However, staff believes that the coverage in the Alteris proposal, with involves higher deductibles and better coverage in some areas (such as inverse condemnation) should be seriously considered by the Board. The total package of coverage with Glatfelters is \$983,978.30, which is less than last year's amount (\$1,048,145.25). The proposal from Alteris is \$720,762.30, a difference of \$263,216.

Greg Johnson of The Johnson Group, Ltd, a professional risk management specialist, makes a presentation at the Board meeting concerning the difference between Glatfelters and Alteris. Mr. Johnson will also provide a comparison of coverage between Alteris and the coverage that would be provided by ACWA-JPIA, which has chosen to defer our application for insurance until next year.

Tom and Jeff Dodds from Tolman and Wiker Insurance will be at the Board meeting to discuss the insurance environment and answer questions about the proposed policies.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve coverage with Argonaut Insurance Co. for property, liability, and the first and third layer of excess liability insurance, quoted at \$422,774; approve crime coverage with Zurich Insurance, quoted at \$8,230; approve the earthquake insurance with Empire Indemnity and Princeton Insurance, quoted at \$198,758.30; and approve the second level of excess liability insurance with RUSI Indemnity for \$91,000.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The adopted budget appropriated \$1,044,260 for general liability and property insurance. The proposed premiums are under budget.

DISCUSSION:

Tolman and Wiker have prepared a comparison between the coverage offered by Glatfelters and the coverage offered by Alteris. The Tolman and Wiker report is attached to this staff report.

In addition to the insurance in the tables above, the District has quotes for terrorism insurance. Staff does not recommend purchase of any terrorism insurance.

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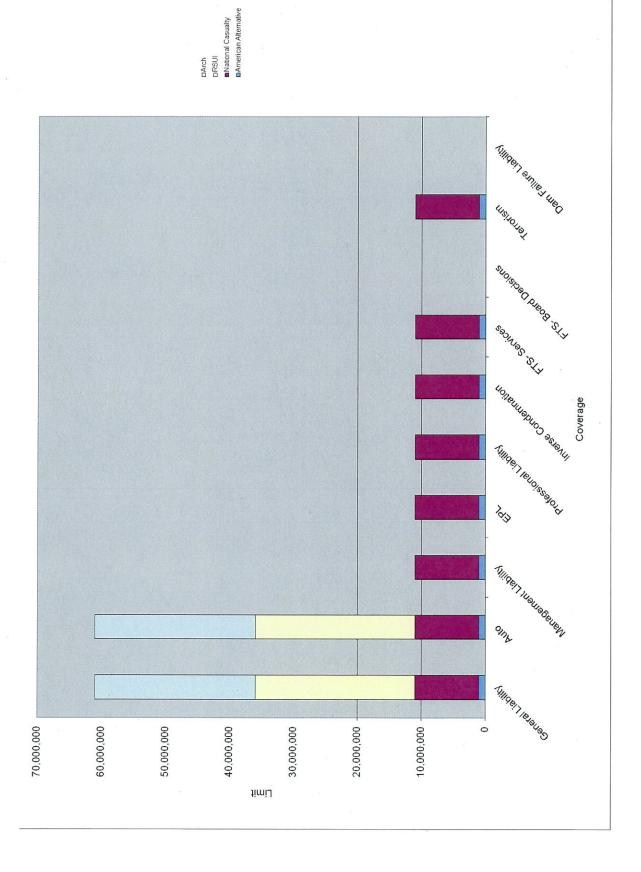

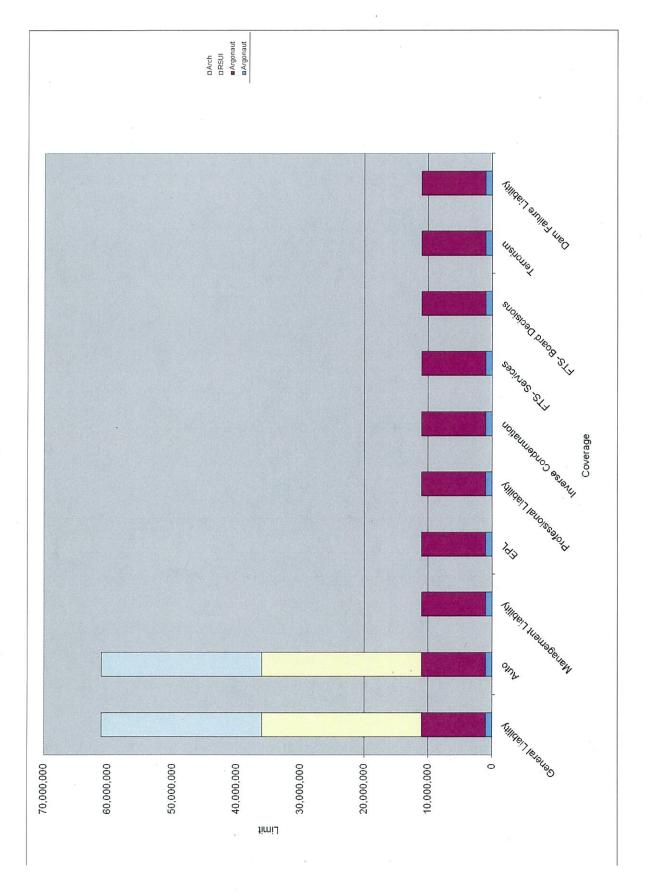

Legal Counsel Lemieux stated subsequent to posting of the agenda the need arose to discuss a Closed Session item entitled "Weber v. Las Virgenes Municipal Water District".

3. PUBLIC COMMENTS

One speaker card was received from the public: (1) Mary Wiesbrock, who stated she was a Las Virgenes Municipal Water District (LVMWD) customer and was unable to attend the September 4th JPA board meeting, requested LVMWD conduct a study on the feasibility of consolidating LVMWD and Oak Park Water District to determine whether there was a favorable financial impact on LVMWD and its ratepayers. If the study is favorable support of the consolidation effort. Ms. Wiesbrock also entered a written letter into the public

record, which will be maintained in the August 28, 2012 agenda folder.

4. ILLUSTRATIVE AND/OR VERBAL PRESENTATION AGENDA ITEMS

A Las Virgenes Unified School District: Presentation of check for Support of Grades 4/5 Water Curriculum - School Year 2012/13

President Renger presented a check to Dr. Dan Stepenosky, Superintendent of Las Virgenes Unified School District (LVUSD). Dr. Stepenosky, LVUSD Board President Jill Gaines and program teacher Anne Trautman thanked the District for supporting the teachers and students who participate in the program. Ms. Trautman discussed the program, student interest and appreciation not only for the financial support, but also for providing the assistance of water district staff.

Board comments included: pirate play using education of water and conservation shows students are getting the message; and pleased program is providing a passion to students and that there is a feeling of a job well done.

Director Peterson stated there was a State Water Project Tour, October 5-7, 2012 and if the group was interested in attending they could contact the District, and he introduced Ms. Yamada an employee of the Metropolitan Water District Board and Las Virgenes customer.

B Recycled Water Seasonal Storage Feasibility Study

Receive and file the June 2012 Recycled Water Seasonal Storage - Project Feasibility Study Report No. 2500.00 and direct staff on next steps.

Director of Facilities and Operations Lippman provided an overview of the Recycled Water Seasonal Storage Project Feasibility Study, discussed Title 16 funding and requirements, potential sites (April Canyon, Hope Site (lowest cost), Stokes Canyon), expanded service (golf course, Decker Canyon, Westlake High School), cost benefit analysis, and stated tonight's requested action was to receive an file the study with the next steps of working with Bureau of Reclamation on Title 16 funding, and program level CEQA documentation for purchase of land for a potential future project.

Board comments and staff responses included: does study include costs without pipelines and use of current program and if not then the study is incomplete (study does not include either item); is cost of NPDES permit included (zero discharge is included, but higher treatment level is not); cost benefit ratio (if we receive grant funding then the cost benefit ratio improves); we need to look at indirect potable reuse; potable supply to recycled water (projections include a future project); why didn't study include a project size for a 50% increase of 1,000 AF (looking at long term); belief that the District needs to be able to get out of the creek and how realistic is a 7% increase per year (Master Plan will bookend analysis); do we want to spend \$150 million on treatment or storage for the future (possible algae permits resulting in high costs could effect the District).

Director Bowman requested the costs be analyzed for 1,000 - 1,200 AF of storage including reduced costs on pipelines.

On a motion by Director Lee Renger, seconded by Director Glen Peterson, the Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Approve the recommendation as presented.

Board comments and staff responses included: accept final report, what does that mean (approve report and reaffirm direction given on June 26, 2012); 218 process additional changes or as is (staff needs to finalize the 218 Notice language, once the 218 Notice is mailed to customers the amounts stated in said notice are "not to exceed" or the 218 process must be redone); and certain data on June 26th was not accurate (dollar amounts on June 26th represented only a snapshot in time).

Director of Facilities and Operations Lippman gave a presentation entitled "Rate Refinement", which summarized June 26th Board direction in regards to sanitation (no increase for two years with a potential increase of 2% in year 3 if needed), recycled (no change in rates) and potable rate structures (spread Metropolitan cost of water over 3-5 years), finalizing Raftelis' report, three-year rate schedule, 218 Notice, 218 hearing, first and second reading of the ordinance, and January 1, 2013 effective date.

Board comments and staff responses included: concerns related to a \$0.56 increase (if this increase is not approved it results in a \$92,000 loss in revenue); water conservation message (lower contributor/lower rates); sewer conservation, how difficult is it to explain calculation (unknown, but outreach and assistance will be provided by staff); unfair to those using 15 or 16 units, and again concerns related to the \$0.56 increase.

On a motion by Director Glen Peterson, seconded by Director Joseph Bowman, the Board of Directors voted 4-1 to Approve moving forward with the proposed potable, recycled and sanitation rate schedule for 3-years; preparation and mailing of the 218 Notice and public hearing to be held on Monday, October 22, 2012; and an increase effective date of January 1, 2013.

Director of Resource Conservation and Public Outreach Reyes gave a presentation entitled "Rates Outreach", which discussed planned rate outreach including issuance of a press release, web posting, newspaper ads, water forums (Westlake Village, Agoura Hills and Calabasas), open house at headquarters, meetings with community groups to discuss drivers for rate increases Metropolitan and Las Virgenes, cost control measures by both agencies, rate changes to potable, recycled and sanitation, discuss the value of water, comparison of rates to other agencies, and message communications including 218 Notice, trends and rate comparison model, and online bill calculator.

9. RESOURCE CONSERVATION AND PUBLIC OUTREACH

A Public Outreach Assessment

Provide feeback to staff.

Ane Deister, Parsons Vice President Environment and Infrastructure gave a presentation entitled "Outreach and Communications Assessment Las Virgenes Municipal Water District", which discussed project guidelines, objectives, methods; comparison with other agencies including details (annual operating budget, total employees, outreach, communications, and conservation); customer survey considerations; key customer survey revelation (high/low median scores); outreach and communications scores; other factors, considerations in assessment; alignment strategic goals/ POCP implementation; snapshot of interactions, views, perceptions; general observation results; findings of opportunities for improvement; recommendations; and guidelines regarding going from good to best.

Ms. Deister recommends the Board discuss and determine (1) perspective: is the agency in a good place; and (2) visioning: use a facilitator for a shared visioning session.

Board comments and staff or consultant responses included: outreach from Board to community (correspondence was sent to homeowners associations and only two responses were received); can the Board meet informally to discuss or must the meeting be noticed (this meeting would need to be considered and noticed as a Special Meeting to comply with The Brown Act); the \$107,000 given to Las Virgenes Unified School District for their 4/5 Science Program, is there any way to get an estimate of value for the money (a competency test is given to students before and after the course to determine knowledge base); focus groups or committees driven by need; collaborative citizen advisory panel didn't work in the past; tactical guidelines; strategic objectives; visioning workshop to be held prior to new general manager start date; improve customer understanding for cost of service (collaborative process doesn't mean people will agree, but you can hear different perspectives); advisory groups are good; Las Virgenes has a lot of outreach, but it's not working (there needs to be performance measures in order to gauge results and if staff doesn't have a clear vision then the strategic goal(s) aren't met); and act as a Board (harness all opinions to get to a "sweet spot").

On a motion by Director Charles Caspary, seconded by Director Joseph Bowman, the Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Approve receiving and filing of Parsons report entitled "Outreach and Communications Assessment - Las Virgenes Municipal Water District". AYES: Director(s) Bowman, Caspary, Peterson, Renger, Steinhardt

1. The Board of Directors of Las Virgenes Municipal Water District met in Special Meeting at 899 North Kanan Road, in Oak Park, California, at 4:30 PM on Tuesday, September 4, 2012.

President Renger called the meeting to order at 4:33 PM.

At the request of President Renger, Director Steinhardt led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Assistant Deputy Secretary Conklin called the roll. Those answering present were Directors Bowman, Caspary, Peterson, Renger and Steinhardt. The Chair declared a guorum present.

Triunfo Sanitation District held a concurrent Special Meeting with their Board of Directors. Triunfo District Manager, Mark Norris called the roll. Those answering present were Directors McReynolds, Orkney, Paule and Wall. Absent: Iceland.

2. Discuss Potential Consolidation of Triunfo Sanitation District with Las Virgenes Municipal Water District: Triunfo Directors Paule and McReynolds gave a presentation entitled "LV and TSD Consolidation". Triunfo Chair, Janna Orkney stated a sub-committee consisting of Directors Paule and McReynolds had prepared and would be giving a presentation on consolidation.

Triunfo Directors, Mike Paule and Mike McReynolds provided a historical overview from 2007 of the Ventura County Grand Jury Report and Local Agency Formation Commission, which encourage agencies to consider consolidation (Triunfo legal counsel and LAFCO agreed there was not an issue with forming a multi-county agency within Ventura/Los Angeles) and previous 2007 discussions with Las Virgenes, during which it was decided not to move forward with the process; both agencies have experienced significant changes and need to consider consolidation to minimize long-term costs to ratepayers; potential benefits to ratepayers (cost savings in operations, administration, operations and maintenance, facilities and elimination of the Joint Powers Authority resulting in administrative cost savings (Las Virgenes has staff and Triunfo does not as they contract for services; two board and two sets of staff – is there a benefit to ratepayers of having one agency); issues to consider (is there an overall advantage or disadvantage to the customers of both agencies), potential fatal flows of consolidation; and next steps (obtain Las Virgenes Board comments and commission an independent study for each agency to include governance, etc.).

Las Virgenes Board comments and Triunfo Board responses included: The Las Virgenes Board never received responses to the questions posed in 2007; believes review of consolidation should move forward, but Las Virgenes cannot afford to do all of the work involved in the process; consider a zone charge for TSD only; may eliminate need for Ventura Regional Sanitation District staff services as they relate to Triunfo; proximity to Oak Park (Las Virgenes versus Ventura County); disappointed questionnaire responses were not received in 2007 (Triunfo Board has different members now than in 2007 and questions could be answered as part of the independent study); if Triunfo does not want to be taken over, what do they want (they do not want to be taken over, but is there a feeling of potential benefit, Las Virgenes has an attitude that Triunfo is lesser of an agency the Las Virgenes is); (this is about ratepayers, ratio of governance, Triunfo has to make contract service decisions by 2014, is there a savings if the agencies consolidate); Director Iceland arrived at 4:55 PM; it's a matter of respect from 2007 that guestions were not answered, if Triunfo is looking to separate from Calleguas it won't happen as Las Virgenes cannot serve water to Oak Park as there are no facilities (Triunfo has talked to Calleguas and it is not known for a fact that Las Virgenes cannot supply water to Oak Park); emergency water can be provided, but not permanent; there are stumbling blocks that need to be addressed as part of a study prior to moving forward.

One speaker card was received from the public: (1) Hal Helsley stated he agrees there is potential for wastewater, but not potable water for Oak Park Water District, and hasn't heard recycled water being discussed.

3. Adjournment: The Chair declared the Special Meeting – Discuss Potential Consolidation of Triunfo Sanitation District with Las Virgenes Municipal Water District adjourned at 5:06 PM.

Subject: Official Transcription of Board Meeting Minutes

SUMMARY:

During the past several months there have been multiple requests from board members to transcribe certain agenda items verbatim or modify verbiage not documented by either the General Manager or Clerk of the Board during the board meeting.

In order to better serve the public and the Board, direction is requested to ensure consistency and methodology for official transcription of minutes (summary minutes with formal actions versus verbatim transcription of all items).

RECOMMENDATION(S):

The Board to provide direction to staff as to the preferred methodology for transcribing of the District's official board meeting minutes.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

None at this time. Depending on the preferred methodology selected, funds may be needed for improving the recording process.

DISCUSSION:

The District's past practice in regards to transcribing of official board meeting minutes has been to prepare a summary of discussions along with the formal vote on each agenda item. If a specific request is made by a board member, that Director's name is documented as part of the record. In the case of general comments during discussions of agenda items the transcription is typically not attributed to an individual board member, and is instead included as a summary of questions and concerns posed to staff, consultants or the public.

Options include: (1) continue with the existing methodology of transcribing summary minutes and to include formal actions taken and formal requests made by the Board of Directors; (2) record all board meetings and have the recording serve as the official minutes transcription; or (3) record all board meetings, maintaining the recording in the agenda folder for a period of 10 years along with a summary transcription to be maintained in perpetuity as the official set of board meeting minutes.

The Las Virgenes Code does not require recordings of board meetings except in the case of a Public Hearing. Should the Board wish to regularly record meetings equipment may have to be modified or added to provide for a better quality recordings for transcription, such as marking recordings at specific action points and setting up microphones to be on all the time to assure comments are captured.

Summary minutes would continue to be transcribed by the Clerk of the Board, and verbatim minutes would require additional staff assistance most likely from the Secretarial staff.

Subject: 4232 Las Virgenes Road - Building #8 Lease Renewal

SUMMARY:

Building # 8, the headquarters building first floor, east end previously known as the Miller Family Suite is now vacant. The tenant moved out on August 31, 2012 and the suite was inspected and all keys returned on Tuesday, September 4, 2012. Staff is recommends hiring the current broker working on the lease for Building #1, Ms. Grace Bartsch, Broker, NAI Capital. Ms. Bartsch has indicated her availability to act as the district's broker in leasing this space. Grace is willing to accept similar terms currently in place for the leasing of building #1. Those terms were competitively bid during the search for a broker in early 2011 for building #1 and NAI Capital was the lowest successful bidder. Staff believes Ms. Bartsch has done an excellent job in bringing prospective clients to the table in light of the current office space leasing environment.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Authorize the General Manager to enter into an agreement with Grace Bartsch, NAI Capital (under similar terms of the agreement executed in February 2011 for the lease of Building #1) to act as the broker in leasing out the existing 4,059 square foot suite on the first floor of Building #8.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The Broker's commission will be determined at the successful negotiation of a new lease. Fiscal year 2012-13 account 701001-5515 budget provides funds for this purpose.

Subject: Tapia Gates and Drives Replacement Project - Final Acceptance

Las Virgenes-Triunfo Joint Powers Authority approved funding for this matter in the Joint Powers Authority Budget. This recommendation is before the LVMWD Board of Directors for action, as administering agent, as authorized in the Joint Powers Authority Agreement.

SUMMARY:

At the June 28, 2011 meeting, the LVMWD Board awarded the contract for the Tapia Gates & Drives Replacement Project to Spiess Construction in the amount of \$245,800 with a completion date of September 1, 2012. The scope of the project was the replacement of several pieces of mechanical equipment found to be non-functional or near the end of their useful life, including 11 sluice gates at primary clarifiers No. 1 through 4, the metal components of the existing sludge collection system in secondary clarifier No. 8, and the drives for sludge collection system at secondary clarifer No. 1 and No. 8.

There was one change order that was issued during the course of construction. Spiess Construction removed an existing slide gate in the influent channel at the primary clarifiers. The slide gate had been stuck in a closed position and could not be removed by staff, thus affecting day to day operations. Additionally, the contractor found that the chain of the sludge collection system to be replaced in Clarifier No. 8 had become brittle and could not be disassembled and put back into service. After an inspection by staff, the contractor was instructed to purchase new chains from the manufacturer and replace the existing chains in Clarifier No. 8. Change Order No. 1 was approved administratively on July 2, 2012, by the General Manager, and ratified by the Board at the July 24, 2012 meeting in the amount of \$23,618.08.

As of August 31, 2012 the project was completed. At this time it is appropriate to file the Notice of Completion, make the final payment and release retention as stipulated in the Contract.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve the final progress payment, in the amount of \$9,287.71 to Spiess Construction Co., Inc.; approve execution of a Notice of Completion by the Secretary of the Board for and on behalf of the District and have the same recorded; and that in the absence of claims from subcontractors and others, release retention in the amount of \$26,941.81 thirty calendar days after filing the Notice of Completion for the Tapia Gates and Drives Replacement Project.

day of completion), as provided in section 3093, Civil Code.

The "owner" who must file for record a notice of completion of a building or other work of improvement means the owner (or his successor in interest at the date of notice is filed) on whose behalf the work was done, though his ownership is less than the fee title. For example, if A is the owner in fee, and B, lessee under a lease, causes a building to be constructed, then B, or whoever has succeeded to his interest at the date the notice is filed, must file the notice.

If the ownership is in two or more persons as joint tenants or tenants in common, the notice may be signed by any one of the co-owners (in fact, the foregoing form is designed for giving of the notice by only one co-tenant), but the names and addresses of the other co-owners must be

The language from 2010 stated:

Pursuant to Section 10515 of the Elections Code, your Board of Directors shall, by resolution, order that an election not be held and immediately request the Board of Supervisors to appoint the persons nominated. Please submit a copy of the resolution to this office. Appointment to such offices must be made at a regular meeting held prior to the date of the election.

Please let me know as soon as possible whether or not Las Virgenes needs to submit a Resolution of no election for Division 1. I need to have the item prepared for our agenda no later than Friday, September 14th.
