MINUTES REGULAR MEETING

5:00 PM January 8, 2013

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

At the request of President Renger, the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was led by Director Caspary.

CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

A Call to order and roll call

The meeting was called to order at 5:02 p.m. by President Renger in the District offices. Assistant Deputy Secretary Conklin called the roll. Those answering present were Directors Caspary, Peterson, Polan, Renger and Steinhardt.

President Renger introduced David Pedersen, who will be assuming the position of General Manager on January 14, 2013.

2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

A Approval of agenda

Interim General Manager Lippman stated a representative from Pedaler's Fork was in the audience and requested "8.D Water Service to 23504 Calabasas Road - Pedaler's Fork" be heard after "3. Public Comments".

On a motion by Director Charles Caspary, seconded by Director Lee Renger, the Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Approve the agenda for the Regular Meeting of January 8, 2013, as amended by Interim General Manager Lippman's recommendation.

4. ILLUSTRATIVE AND/OR VERBAL PRESENTATION AGENDA ITEMS

A Public Hearing: Potable Water Replacement Fund Standby Charge

The full reading of the proposed Ordinance as it relates to continuation of the Water Replacement Fund Standby Charge for fiscal year commencing July 1, 2013, be waived, and the Board order publication within 30-days of adoption using a summary of the ordinance. The Board by a roll call vote of Ayes: Noes: Abstain: Absent: that Rules and Regulations for Water Standby Charge Deferrals be approved; and the proposed Ordinance as it relates to continuation of the Water Replacement Fund Standby Charge for fiscal year commencing July 1, 2013, be given first reading by title only.

President Renger opened the public hearing and provided the history of standby charges; Secretary Caspary stated a public hearing notice had been published twice in The Daily News; Interim General Manager Lippman discussed the use of standby charge funds, stated one inquiry had been received by DataStream related to whether a senior discount was available and that no other inquires, verbal or written had been received.

No speaker cards were received from the public.

President Renger closed the public hearing.

On a motion by Director Charles Caspary, seconded by Director Glen Peterson, the Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Approve the recommendations as presented (waive the full reading of the proposed Ordinance and order publication within 30-days of adoption using a summary of the ordinance).

On a motion by Director Charles Caspary, seconded by Director Glen Peterson, the Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Approve by roll call vote conducted by Assistant Deputy Secretary Conklin, the recommendations as presented (approve Rules and Regulations for Water Standby Deferrals and the proposed Ordinance to be given the first reading by title only). Legal Counsel Lemieux gave the first reading of the Ordinance by title only. AYES: Director(s) Caspary, Peterson, Polan, Renger, Steinhardt

Legal Counsel Lemieux stated nominations do not need a second and officers can be elected on a 3-2 vote.

Director Peterson nominated Director Caspary for Board President, which was seconded by Director Renger. Director Polan nominated Director Steinhardt for Board President.

Director Steinhardt inquired as to what the protocol is (Legal Counsel Lemieux went over Robert's Rules and stated votes must be public).

On a motion by Director Lee Renger, seconded by Director Glen Peterson, the Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Approve closing nominations.

On a motion by Director Glen Peterson, seconded by Director Lee Renger, the Board of Directors voted 3-2 to Approve the election of Charles Caspary as Board President.

At this point in the meeting the gavel was passed from Director Renger to President Caspary.

B Election of Vice President: Board of Directors - Las Virgenes Municipal Water District

Director Caspary nominated Director Peterson for Board Vice President, which was seconded by Director Renger.

On a motion by Director Lee Renger, seconded by Director Glen Peterson, the Board of Directors voted 4-1 to Approve closing nominations.

On a motion by Director Charles Caspary, seconded by Director Lee Renger, the Board of Directors voted 4-1 to Approve the election of Glen Peterson as Board Vice President.

The Secretary of Las Virgenes Municipal Water District hereby appoints Kimmey Conklin as Assistant Deputy Secretary during the term of my office.

Legal Counsel Lemieux stated it was unnecessary to appoint an Assistant Deputy Secretary as multiple Deputy appointments can be made for business purposes, and recommended the General Manager and Clerk of the Board be appointed as Deputies.

Secretary Steinhardt appointed General Manager Pedersen (incoming General Manager effective January 14, 2013) and Clerk of the Board Conklin as Deputy Secretaries during his term as Board Secretary.

E Election of Treasurer: Board of Directors - Las Virgenes Municipal Water District

The Board of Directors to nominate and approve the election of Treasurer of the Board of Directors.

Director Renger nominated Director Polan for Board Treasurer, which was seconded by Director Caspary.

On a motion by Director Glen Peterson, seconded by Director Lee Renger, the Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Approve closing nominations.

On a motion by Director Lee Renger, seconded by Director Charles Caspary, the Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Approve the election of Leonard Polan as Board Treasurer.

F Treasurer: Appointment of Deputy Treasurer

The Treasurer of Las Virgenes Municipal Water District hereby appoints Sandra Hicks as Deputy Treasurer during the term of my office.

Treasurer Polan appointed Director of Finance and Administration Hicks as Deputy Treasurer during his term as Board Treasurer.

G Leonard Polan: ACWA Expenses

Provide direction to staff as to whether or not Mr. Polan is to reimburse \$212.84 for unused travel expenses.

Interim General Manager Lippman provided a history of the invitation and approval of expenses from the November 27, 2012 board meeting.

Director Steinhardt stated Mr. Polan was invited to the ACWA conference in San Diego as a guest, there was confusion as to what policies his attendance was under and that as a guest, not as a seated board member he was not covered by District policy.

On a motion by Director Barry Steinhardt, seconded by Director Charles Caspand the

Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Approve reimbursing Mr. Polan \$190.36 (mileage and meal expense), and that as a guest he was not obligated to reimburse the District \$212.84 for unused travel expenses. President Caspary requested staff provide a copy of the Business Expense Policy to the Board of Directors.

8. FACILITIES AND OPERATIONS

A Edison Easement Acquisition at APN 2069-084-901

Approve and accept the purchase value of \$2,518.00 in exchange for granting an easement to Edison as shown in the Exhibit A and B; and authorize the General Manager to execute necessary documents in a form approved by the District Counsel.

Interim General Manager Lippman discussed the easement request and provided information to Director Polan in regards to possession of the slab and regulating of power/voltage to the pump station and community.

On a motion by Director Lee Renger, seconded by Director Charles Caspary, the Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Approve the recommendations as presented.

B Irrigation Control

Direct staff if additional investigation is necessary.

Interim General Manager Lippman stated this item was brought forward as a result of public comments and Board direction received on November 13, 2012, what would trigger the District to turnoff devices; and discussed questions and answers from an internal memo dated December 21, 2012 (Subject: Irrigation Control Concept to Eliminate the Need for Storage).

A summary of Board comments and responses included: Renger: opposed (when the District moved to smart meters customers were told we couldn't control their water usage), believes the suggestion was to stop or delay the tank, if voluntary we would have to delay the tank while we determined if enough customers volunteered for the program, if device was controlled by cell, phone or internet there would be problems during emergencies; Steinhardt: this would be a voluntary program, shutoff would be triggered by rain, don't look at the negatives, look at the positives, technology exists (Lippman, yes, but it has to be modified in order to use with our existing system), it's for the District's betterment to conserve water instead of building the tank, 10-11 hour delay in getting the reservoir up, lawns wouldn't turn brown in that length of time (Caspary: if you look at tank levels at 10:00 a.m. the levels have gone down), do we believe the numbers in the reports (Renger: believes fire-flow requirement from fire department is too low especially in the west end of system), 3 million versus 5 million gallon tank, again are numbers accurate, look at conservation: Peterson: the device mentioned does not currently exist, concerned about program costs and Civil Rights issues, if a device is created in the future then look at it, uses too much staff time and is opposed to it, also discussed City of Yorba Linda's difficulties when their reservoir was not built, water ran out during a fire event resulting in 12-18 homes burning, file and bring back don't spend a lot of money on staff time (Renger: agrees with Peterson, Steinhardt: opposite position from Peterson); Caspary: Chart 1 (Lippman: explanation of day to day demand and what triggers device), customers need to have choices about water use on their properties, tough sell if telling customers through voluntary program that they could lose landscaping; Polan: when is fire-flow needed and what do we need fire-flow for (Caspary: system redundancy, to meet county requirements: Lippman: structures), what do you see for meeting 20x2020 (Caspary: higher rates, Peterson: there are many ways to meet 20x2020, one way is to assign budgets to customers), another tenks and

then the treatment plant will need to be updated, the District is looking at spending \$7 million on a tank and treatment plant construction (Caspary: doesn't disagree with looking at "water is water" (potable/recycled), 63% of customers would have to participate, ask everyone in Westlake Village to participate in the program with notification their lawns may turn brown).

On a motion by Director Glen Peterson, seconded by Director Lee Renger, the Board of Directors voted 3-2 to take no formal action except to file the information provided by staff, staff was directed to not spend a lot of money (time wise) and to bring back additional information on irrigation control technology as it becomes available.

C Los Angeles County Clean Water, Clean Beaches Measure

Provide staff direction on the Los Angeles County Clean Water, Clean Beaches Measure pertaining to Las Virgenes proprieties.

Interim General Manager Lippman stated this item had been discussed at the JPA board meeting held on January 7, 2013, and was before the Las Virgenes Board for discussion on the portion of fees, payment of which would be the sole responsibility of the District.

A summary of Board comments and responses included: Steinhardt: do not file a protest but put a letter together asking what the money will be spent on (Caspary: send updated drafts as available; Lippman: letter to county regarding measure, not enough details, updates, our watershed and how it is affected, who regulates); Polan: heard about Monterey Formation brackish water in Malibu Creek who oversees (Caspary: watershed has to have three projects).

President Caspary directed staff to send a letter to the county not in protest, but requesting further information as detailed herein.

D Water Service to 23504 Calabasas Road - Pedaler's Fork

Direct staff if a credit of \$7,400 should be applied to the connection fee for the new 1-1/2 inch service for 23504 Calabasas Road.

Interim General Manager Lippman provided a history of Department of Water and Power service and meter size; Legal Counsel Lemieux stated the process was lawful, but not part of the Las Virgenes Code as the meter is from the 1940s, which is prior to the District's formation.

Director Renger inquired as to whether DWP would abandon the service and what the physical change would cost the District (Lippman: the customer paid \$21,000 for the new meter); and Director Peterson inquired as to whether the service was within City of Los Angeles (Lippman: no, the service is within the Las Virgenes service area).

On a motion by Director Glen Peterson, seconded by Director Charles Caspary, the Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Approve a credit in the amount of \$7,400 to be applied to the connection fee for the new 1-1/2 inch service for 23504 Calabasas Road.

A Buyer Position

Approve the job description for the Buyer position.

Director of Finance and Administration Hicks stated hiring of a Buyer versus Senion Buyer

would result in a salary savings of 13%.

Director Polan inquired as to whether the position required a Bachelors Degree (Hicks: a Bachelor's would be great, but the job description states an Associate's Degree is desirable).

On a motion by Director Barry Steinhardt, seconded by Director Charles Caspary, the Board of Directors voted 5-0 to Approve the recommendation as presented. AYES: Director(s) Caspary, Peterson, Polan, Renger, Steinhardt

10. INFORMATION ITEMS

A Free Toro Sprinkler Nozzle Replacements for Single Family Residential Customers

Director of Resource Conservation and Public Outreach Reyes provided an overview of the program.

A summary of Board comments and responses included: Polan: Eastern Municipal Water District (Reyes: in 2-years 17,000 nozzles, outreach was bill stuffers); Renger: do nozzles save money (Reyes: unsure), with smart meters can we monitor irrigation usage (Reyes: yes, over time, Steinhardt: shocked by comment as we told customers we would never monitor usage, Caspary: we may want to use usage to develop a program), can we see how this works (Lippman: recommends a pilot program using voluntary participants); Caspary: you get brown spots, do outreach for all rebate programs.

B Lemieux and O'Neill: Hourly Litigation/Consultation Rate Adjustment

A summary of Board comments and responses included: Caspary inquired as to the percentage of the increases (Legal Counsel Lemieux stated he was unsure of his percentage); Peterson: retainer for Lemieux and O'Neill is the same \$6,000 per month.

C Recycled Water Seasonal Storage Feasibility Study Update

Interim General Manager Lippman stated the study had been sent to the Bureau of Reclamation for consideration as an approved Title XVI study; next steps: share with local representatives, develop a brief summary document from the report, with redistricting Las Virgenes now has four representatives versus two, ACWA/CASA DC conferences for partnerships (one board member is currently attending) and set-up meetings with legislative representatives.

A summary of Board comments and responses included: Renger: appalled at potential regulations, none of the three reservoirs would get the District out of the creek (Lippman: the TEA study looked at staying out of the creek all of the time, in 100% of the situations and none of the scenarios enable the District to be out of the creek 100% of the time), could reservoirs be made larger (Lippman: sizes are part of the feasibility project), can reservoirs be used as a treatment location for cleaning of effluent (Lippman: not considered as additional treatment in feasibility study); Polan: time-frame for looking back at a larger reservoir (Lippman: 9-10 months for a revised study and you couldn't apply for State funds again); Caspary: current study has a \$3 million appropriation; Peterson: thought reservoir in Stokes Canyon was going to take all the recycled (Lippman: recycle study since the 1970s), contact Norm Buehring regarding the history.

Subject: District's Radio System Upgrade

SUMMARY:

The Federal Communication Commission (FCC) mandated that all public safety radio systems operate within the 12.5 kilohertz narrow-band range by January 1, 2013. On October 9, 2012, the Board authorized the General Manager to enter into an agreement with Destin Thomas for the purchase and installation of new radio equipment required to comply with the FCC mandate. All hilltop and facility repeaters, handheld, mobile vehicle, and base-station radios have been replaced to meet the new requirements.

Because the previous analog radio system evolved over many decades, more radio equipment was discovered to require replacement during updgrade of the radio system than originally anticpated. The additional equipment that required replacement included five repeaters, eight 5-gigahertz transceivers with dish antennas, and an extra handheld and mobile radio unit. The cost of the additional equipment was \$23,700.51, which was not accounted for in the vendor's original scope of work.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Appropriate funds in the amount of \$23,700.51 for the purchase of the additional radio equipment for the Radio System Upgrade Project.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

On October 9, 2012, the Board approved a budget of \$118,139.79 for Job No. 10490. The total project budget is now \$141,840.30, including the additional appropriation of \$23,700.51.

Subject: Equestrian Tank Evaluation (LVMWD Report No. 2508.00)

SUMMARY:

Equestrian Tank is a concrete reservoir built in 1970 that is located on Glenbridge Road in Westlake Village. A routine inspection of the tank in 2004 revealed that its concrete is affected by alkali-silica reaction (ASR) cracking. ASR occurs due to a chemical reaction between highly alkaline cement products and non-crystalline forms of silica aggregate. The cause of ASR is linked to sand quarried from the Santa Clara River near Oxnard, which is no longer used for concrete on District's projects. The ASR process was not well understood at the time of the tank's construction. As ASR cracking progresses, the concrete reinforcing bars can be exposed to corrosion, resulting in the compromised structural integrity of the tank.

Since 2004, the District has conducted four structural inspections of the tank to monitor the progression of ASR-related damage. HDR completed the most recent inspection in November 2012 and prepared a technical memorandum summarizing their findings. HDR found that no significant progression of cracking had occurred and no new areas of cracking were observed. Additionally, most of the existing cracks were tight and filled with calcium carbonate deposits. The columns and pilasters have experienced the most significant cracking; however, no noticable changes were observed since the prior inspection.

To extend the useful life of the tank, HDR recommends that the District rehabilitate the columns and pilasters by wrapping them with carbon fiber reinforced plastic within the next two years and, upon completion of the work, inspect the tank on a 5-year cycle. Staff proposes to budget for the rehabilitation project, currently estimated to cost approximately \$350,000, in FY 2014-2015.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Receive and file the 2012 Equestrian Tank Evaluation Report No. 2508.00.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

There is no financial impact with this action. The project to rehabilitate the tank is currently estimated to cost approximately \$350,000, including \$50,000 for design and \$300,000 for construction.

Subject: Claims by Michaels Stores, Inc. and Costco Wholesale

SUMMARY:

On January 8, 2013, the District received a claim from Michaels Stores, Inc. for water damages associated with a broken fire sprinkler system at its Westlake Village store. A similar claim was received from Costco Wholesale on January 22, 2013 for damages at its facility, which is adjacent to the Michaels store. Although the claimants cited different dates for the damages (November 19th and 21st), staff believes that the incidents are related and may have been caused by a temporary increase water pressure that ocurred on the west end of District's transmission system on November 19, 2012. At that time, the water system pressure increased from 157 to 184 psi for approximately twenty minutes.

The claim from Michaels originally estimated damages to be \$14,101; however, a subsequent phone call from Michaels' Risk Manager indicated that the damages were more than originally expected due the need to replace tile and could exceed \$100,000. The Costco claim included an invoice for repairs totaling \$1,963.43, which is the amount that Costco cited in its claim.

Staff investigated the claim and determined that the fire sprinkler line breaks occurred in both stores at approximately the time of the increased pressure in the west end of the District's water system. Staff requested that the District's claims adjuster, Sierra West Adjusters, perform an independent investigation and determine the District's liablility, if any, for the damages. Staff and Sierra West consulted with the District's legal counsel during the investigation. Legal counsel cited that the District may invoke the so-called "fire hydrant immunity" contained in Government Code Section 850.4:

"Neither a public entity, nor a public employee acting in the scope of his employment, is liable for any injury resulting from the condition of fire protection or firefighting equipment or facilities...".

Legal counsel cited a number of cases that have consistently upheld immunity to public agencies for damages associated with fire protection systems, even when those systems are not being used for fire fighting purposes. Based on this information, legal counsel recommended that the District deny the claims.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Deny the claims from Michaels Stores, Inc. and Costco Wholesale.
