

# CITY OF HIDDEN HILLS - JIM BRIDGER ROAD PIPELINE REPLACEMENT

March 2013

## THE PROJECT

To improve service reliability, LVMWD will replace a 200-foot section of pipeline on an access road that provides service to 24944, 24948 and 24954 Jim Bridger Road.

### WHAT'S BEING DONE

The existing 2-inch pipeline providing potable water service to the end of the access road has reached the end of its service life. It will be replaced with a new section of 4-inch pipeline.

### TIMEFRAME

Once the project begins, it is expected that two weeks will be needed to complete the pipeline replacement. This schedule is an estimate, subject to delays due to weather or other factors.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

There will be brief interruptions of water service to the properties listed above at the beginning and toward the end of the project. During the project, there will be excavating equipment, trucks, delivery vehicles and personnel present at the site. A moderate amount of noise can be expected. When construction commences, be sure any pets are safely contained and secure. Vehicular access may be delayed during construction hours. It is recommended that recreational activities (e.g. bicycles, equestrians) avoid the area during the construction period. When the pipeline is installed, disrupted pavement will be restored. Normal work hours are weekdays (Mon – Fri) from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

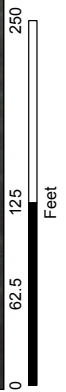
