## **LVMWD Releases Annual Water Quality Report**

CALABASAS, CA June 27, 2014 – Las Virgenes Municipal Water District (LVMWD) has released and mailed its annual Water Quality Report to homes and businesses in the District's 122 square-mile service area. The report is also available online at www.LVMWD.com. Additional printed copies are also available at District Headquarters in Calabasas. The annual publication of test results reflects water quality analyses conducted during 2013. As in years past, the report shows that LVMWD customers are provided with very high quality drinking water.

The publication of an annual Water Quality Report, also called a Consumer Confidence Report, is a state and federal requirement. LVMWD General Manager David W. Pedersen said, "Providing safe and reliable water supplies to the residents, schools and business in our region is the District's highest priority. While the drought has focused our attention on how precious and fragile our water supplies may be, customers also need to know the quality of the drinking water served by LVMWDs is excellent, safe and it's healthy to consume."

Las Virgenes Municipal Water District provides water service to the cities of Agoura Hills, Calabasas, Hidden Hills, Westlake Village and adjacent unincorporated areas of Los Angeles county.
