April 14, 2009

The Board of Directors of Las Virgenes Municipal Water District met in Regular Meeting at 4232 Las Virgenes Road, in Calabasas, California, at 5:00 PM on Tuesday, April 14, 2009.

President Caspary called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was given, led by President Caspary.

Secretary Peterson called the roll. Those answering present were Directors Bowman, Caspary, Peterson, Renger and Smith.

The Chair declared a quorum present.

- 2 It was then moved by Director Renger, seconded by Director Bowman, and unanimously carried, that the agenda for the Regular Meeting of April 14, 2009 be approved as presented.
- 3 Public Comments –Two speaker's cards were received from the public. Mr. Freeman Hall and Mr. Michael Stern both representing Solar Electronic Solutions. They each spoke in support of their proposal previously submitted to the District.
- 4 Illustrative and/or Verbal Presentation Agenda Items Strategic Workforce Planning Update Human Resources Manager Hector Valdez presented to the Board a summary of the Workforce Planning policy and programs to date.
- It was moved by Director Peterson, seconded by Director Renger, and unanimously carried, that the Consent Calendar Items 6A-6D be approved as presented.

 - D Tapia Water Reclamation Facility BNR Centrate Treatment Project Ratification of Change Order #4: ratify Change order #4 for the Tapia BNR Centrate Treatment project in the amount of \$18,539.00.
- 6 Miscellaneous Report from Treasurer None.
- A Headquarters Lobby Security Improvements -- It was moved by Director Peterson, seconded by Director Renger, and unanimously carried, that the Board authorize the General Manager to issue a purchase order in the amount of \$55,441.00 to Ventura Builders for the Headquarters Security Improvements; and appropriate funds in the amount of \$70,000 to Job Number 10417 to complete this work.
- B Proposal for Continued Monitoring of Inclinometers in the Vicinity of Lorenzo Court and Consuelo Drive -- It was moved by Director Renger, seconded by Director Bowman, and unanimously carried, that the Board approve the proposal from Fugro-West to continue monitoring of inclinometers in the vicinity of Lorenzo Court and Consuelo Drive for a additional year at an estimated cost of \$35,000.00.

- C Purchase of Laboratory Equipment -- It was moved by Director Peterson, seconded by Director Renger, and unanimously carried, that the Board authorize the General Manager to execute a purchase order for purchase of the QuickChem 8500 Series 2 FIA/IC+ with Lachat Instruments in an amount not to exceed \$82,000, including tax and freight; and appropriate additional funds in the amount of \$2,000 to fully fund the purchase.
- Resolution to Set Allocation Level and Surcharge Director Peterson reported that Metropolitan Water District Board approved a Level 2 Regional Water Shortage and a rate increase of 19.7 percent effective September 1, 2009. The rate increase includes a Delta surcharge to be used for Delta improvements. General Manager Mundy summarized board actions, outreach activities, and measures the District has undertaken since the Water Shortage Response Plan was adopted in June 2008. Mr. Mundy recommended Board adoption of the Resolution 04-09-2388 to implement water allocation to customer classification and a surcharge of \$3.00 per hundred cubic feet. Civil Engineering Associate Mike Brown presented information on water budgets and that they are not based on historical usage, but based on lot size. There will be no penalty for customers that are under their budget.

It was moved by Director Renger, seconded by Director Caspary, and carried unanimously, that the Board reaffirm the water shortage response framework presented and approved on March 10, 2009 and summarized in the board memorandum dated April 14, 2009; and adopt the proposed Resolution No. 04-09-2388, which establishes water supply allocation levels and a surcharge for conservation purposes pursuant to a Regional Shortage Level declaration by Metropolitan Water District of Southern California.

General Manager Mundy discussed Carlos Reyes' promotion from Operations Manager to Director of Resource Conservation and Public Outreach and welcomed him to his first board meeting as Department Head.

- 8 A Westlake Filtration Facility/Las Virgenes Dam Seepage Monitoring Project: Award of Contract It was moved by Director Bowman, seconded by Director Peterson, and unanimously carried, that the Board approve the award of the contract for the Westlake Filtration Facility Seepage Monitoring Project to Instrument Control Services in the amount of \$37,391.50; and that the remaining bids be rejected upon receipt of duly executed contract documents; and appropriate funds in the amount of \$20,000 to Job Number 10377 to complete this work.

- (1) MWD Representative Peterson provided an update regarding general business of Metropolitan Water District including the Bay-Delta Management Report and his attendance at the American Canal dedication.
- (2) Other Directors Bowman, Peterson and Renger reported on their attendance at the AWA Symposium of April 16, 2009. Director Peterson reported on his participation in an ACWA tour with the Water Education Foundation; and attendance at ACWA state legislative meetings held on April 24, 2009. President Caspary discussed his attendance at the Council of Governments meeting of April 6, 2009 during which Tracy Egoscue, Executive Officer of the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Board discussed stormwater pollution and cities responsibilities; and his attendance at the April 16, 2009 Santa Monica Bay Restoration Committee meeting which included discussions of stormwater cleaning; a proposed ballot measure by Los Angeles County Flood Control District; AB 139 and State of the Bay update.
 - B Directors' Reports on Outside meetings None
- C Information Items (1) Temporary Personnel to Support Water Allocation General Manager Mundy discussed temporary staffing and training needed to handle customer inquiries related to water budgets. Legal Counsel Lemieux recommended the Board not respond individually to customer inquiries related to water budgets and allocations as they may be making final determinations during the appeals process; and that further discussion of this item would require placement on a future agenda.

- D General Manager Mundy provided an update regarding general business of the District including the April 18, 2009 Administrative Code Review Workshop and next steps. The Board requested an additional workshop be scheduled for discussion and review the Code. Legal Counsel Lemieux requested the Board review Titles 3, 4 and 5; and devise a list of questions and/or clarifications prior to the workshop. Director Bowman requested a red-line version of Titles 1 and 2.
- E Director's Comments Director Bowman commented on the recent solar project update; water budget availability for the City of Westlake Village Council Meeting; and difficulties in utilizing the on-line credit card payment option. Director Peterson commented on State Revolving Fund grant monies, which could be utilized for a solar project at Rancho.
- Future Agenda Items Director Bowman stated he had made a formal request for benefit costs, which have doubled in the last 4-5 years to be placed on an agenda; and since we are not conducting a classification and compensation study he wants to know what other agencies are doing in regards to compensation and whether agencies are negotiating 1 or 3 year contracts. Legal Counsel Lemieux notified the Board that this item cannot be discussed until the topic is listed on an agenda. Director Peterson stated that LVMWD should be purchasing MWD water and filling the 7-foot freeboard at Westlake Reservoir prior to the September 1, 2009 rate increases.
- The meeting convened into Closed Session at 6:57 p.m. to discuss the Claim/Tolling Agreement—County of Los Angeles and Los Angeles County Flood Control District

Emergency Paving Repairs, Cornell Road South of Mulholland

SUMMARY

On Wednesday night, April 22nd, the 14" water main on Cornell Road, approximately 150 feet north of the intersection at Mulholland Highway failed. Repairs to the water main and temporary repairs to the road were quickly made by the district's construction staff. However, the force of the water damaged a substantial amount of the pavement on both lanes of Cornell Road. As Cornell Road is a major thoroughfare in the area, the L.A. County Department of Public Works and the County Fire Department required that at least one lane on Cornell remain open during the permanent paving operation. This required an additional paving day and substantially increased the cost of repairs. The initial paving estimate was \$23,715. The final invoice from S&S Paving included an increase of \$10,375 to cover the cost of the additional paving day, bringing the total cost of the permanent repair to \$34,090.00.

RECOMMENDATION

 Ratify the General Manager's approval of Purchase Order No. 20650 OO in the amount of \$34,090 for emergency paving repairs to Cornell Road.

Irrigation Pipe and Fittings

Las Virgenes Municipal Water District (LVMWD) and Triunfo Sanitation District Joint Powers Authority have approved funding for this matter in the Joint Powers Authority Budget. This recommendation is before the LVMWD Board of Directors for action, as administering agent, as authorized under the Joint Powers Authority Agreement.

SUMMARY

Currently, the District has a large supply of obsolete and/or damaged irrigation pipe and fittings previously used at the various recycled water spray fields and now stored at Rancho. The District has no need for the pipe and may realize some revenues by its sale. The Foundation for Pierce College has expressed interest in some of the pipe and fittings for use on the college farm. Other potential buyers include scrap dealers.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- · Declare the irrigation pipe and fittings surplus; and
- Authorize the General Manager to negotiate the sale of a portion of the irrigation pipe and fittings
 to the Foundation for Pierce College and the remainder to other buyers at a fair price related to
 the scrap value of the pipe.

Staff estimates the scrap value of the pipe and fittings at a total value of \$8,500.

Award of Bid for Janitorial Service

<u>SUMMARY</u>

On April 28, 2009 the Board of Directors approved a call for bids for the purchase of janitorial service for all district locations. Bids were received and opened publicly on Tuesday, May 26, 2009.

RECOMMENDATION

The Board of Directors authorize the General Manager to issue a one year contract with two one-year renewal options to Century Maintenance for Janitorial Service at \$5,450 per month.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Estimated annual cost to the district for Janitorial Service is \$65,400.00. This amount is less than the previous year's expense of \$69,948, resulting in an annual savings of \$4,548.00 for this service. Funds are available in the current budget and will be proposed in future budgets.

DISCUSSION

Invitation for bid proposals was sent to fifteen service providers, six responses were received ranging from \$5,450 per month to \$9,835 per month.

Century Maintenance, Inc. Company is the apparent lowest responsible bidder. Staff has reviewed the required documentation and verified references. Staff recommends the contract be awarded to Century Maintenance Inc. to provide janitorial services to all district locations.

Prepayment of PERS FY09-10 Expense (Not OPEB)

SUMMARY

PERS allows member agencies a discount of 3.66% if the estimated expense for the fiscal year is prepaid between July 1 and July 15. The estimated expense for FY09-10 is \$1,561,887. With the discount offered, the lump sum payment would be \$1,504,669 for a savings of \$57,281. Current interest rates are less than the effective 7.75% annual interest rate on the discount offered by PERS. Staff recommends that the expense be prepaid.

RECOMMENDATION

Authorize prepayment of the PERS expense for FY09-10, to be paid between July 1 and July 15, 2009.

DISCUSSION

FY04-05 was the first year in many years that LVMWD incurred an expense for the employer's share of retirement costs. Staff recommended, and the Board approved, the same prepayment with discount that PERS currently offers. In retrospect, it was a good decision because interest rates of available investments remained low through most of FY04-05. The Board also approved the prepayment every year since then.

The prepayment for FY08-09 was \$1,474,183.

* <u>Pay this amount (see attachment):</u> Your pre-payment 2009-2010 Employer Contribution is from your June 30, 2007 actuarial valuation report. It has been reduced by a half year interest credit at the 7.75% actuarial assumed interest rate (resulting in an approximate 3.66% discount). To the extent your actual 2009-2010 payroll or CalPERS actual 2009-10 net investment earnings differ from our assumptions, we anticipate the differences will be reflected in your 2012-2013 and later employer contribution rates. If your rate plan is in a risk pool, these earnings and payroll differences will be shared by all employers in that risk pool, under current practice.

Conservation Rebate Program Funding

SUMMARY

The current fiscal year has seen a marked increase in requests for conservation program rebates throughout the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California's (MWD) service area. This has resulted not only in additional expenditures for these programs by MWD, but a large backlog in rebate applications that have yet to be paid by MWD due to a budget shortfall. MWD Conservation Staff are currently developing short-term and long-term strategies to manage funding for the program, subject to MWD Board approval on June 9. At present, funding for the program is suspended.

Considering the current water shortage situation, the current mandatory conservation measures that District customers are subject to, the impending water budget allotments and overuse penalties to take effect July 1, 2009, and the upcoming scheduled water rate increase, staff recommends continuing the existing water conservation rebate program.

RECOMMENDATION

 Appropriate \$50,000 from water fund reserves to fund the District's residential water conservation rebate programs immediately and through FY 2009-2010.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

In FY 05-06, the District processed the largest amount of rebate at about \$40,000. The amount was funded by both Prop. 50 grant and the MWD rebate program. Staff finds that a funding of \$50,000 at this time is appropriate, contingent upon MWD Board action.

OPEB Payment for FY08/09

SUMMARY

The District will be submitting its first OPEB payment to PERS in June 2009 for the fiscal year FY 2008/09. The total amount for the year, representing the annual actuarial liability, is \$782,570. However, the District has paid \$454,390 for retiree health insurance during the year, so only the difference of \$328,180 must be submitted to CALPERS.

Until the economy turned in 2008, the plan was to prefund the OPEB liability and begin drawing down on the balance to fund retiree medical. However, staff recommends preserving liquidity at this time, so only the minimum payment will be made at this time. As the economy improves, prefunding can again be reconsidered.

Another actuarial study will be required before June 30, 2010. Funds have already been included in the proposed budget.

Subject National Theatre for Children 2009/2010

SUMMARY

As part of the school education outreach program, LVMWD sponsors The National Theatre for Children (NTC) performances at local schools and public libraries. Emphasizing water awareness and conservation while also providing entertainment, these live theatre presentations are aimed at students in grades K - 3. NTC has been an effective outreach program at local schools and libraries since 1993.

In 2009-10, the production will be "The Aqua League and the Draught Dilemma" and promises to be a memorable learning experience for the primary grade audience.

Over 3,000 children in LVMWD's service area experienced these performances during the school year in FY 08/09. In addition, performances at our local libraries reach the pre-school audience and their parents. Local newspapers provide outreach to the home-schooled segment of the community, including their parents and teachers.

Reaching children at an early age to promote water conservation awareness is an important part of LVMWD's community outreach goals. In addition, take-home materials are part of the NTC experience, bringing the conservation message home to parents.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The program cost is \$7,280 and funded in the proposed 2009-10 budget under account number 101900.6602.
