CALABASAS, CA - June 23, 2016 – Las Virgenes Municipal Water District (LVMWD) has released and mailed its 2015 Water Quality Report to homes and businesses in the District's 122 square-mile service area. The report is also available online at www.LVMWD.com. The annual publication of test results reflects water quality analyses conducted during 2015 and shows that LVMWD customers continue to receive very high quality drinking water.

The publication of an annual Water Quality Report, also called a "Consumer Confidence Report," is a state and federal requirement. LVMWD General Manager David W. Pedersen said, "Over the last year, the statewide drought and the water crisis in Flint, Michigan serve to remind us that a supply of clean, safe and reliable water is essential to our quality of life."

Because there are no local sources, LVMWD's water supply travels hundreds of miles and is then treated prior to delivery. Metropolitan Water District of Southern California and LVMWD personnel perform water quality tests at numerous locations in the service area throughout the year. The 2015 report reflects the findings, which show that LVMWD's water meets all state and federal drinking water standards.

Las Virgenes Municipal Water District provides drinking water to the cities of Agoura Hills, Calabasas, Hidden Hills, Westlake Village and adjacent unincorporated areas of Los Angeles County.
