Subject: AWWA Standard Water Balance and Audit for FY 07-08, Report #2449.00

SUMMARY:

The "Water Leak/Leak Detection and Water System Loss Control Study" was funded by Southern California Edison (SCE). This program is designed to access the nexus between water loss and energy and to pilot test the AWWA water audits methodology and the AWWA recommended leakage intervention methodologies. Las Virgenes Municipal Water District (LVMWD) was invited to participate in the SCE program and to work with Water System Optimization (WSO), the consultant specializes in water loss management. There are two phases of studies in the program; Phase I was top down water audit and economic level of leakage analysis. Phase II was Leakage field measurements through establishment of District Metered Areas (DMA) and proactive leakage intervention through leak detection and repair and pressure management. Water Balance for the District was established for fiscal year 2007/2008 for Phase I of this study. Scope included source meters testing, billing data analysis, and customer meters accuracy evaluation. Results indicate that the apparent losses are minimal and real losses are about 4%.

Phase II of the study is to apply the DMA method, for leakage intervention to two subsystems: (1) Seminole-Latigo and Three Spring System, and (2) Twin Lake and Upper Twin Lake system. In each of the DMA studies, water loss volume was assessed over one week in the initial monitoring period, followed with a detailed leak detection campaign, and then final water loss volume was assessed to quantify the reduction of water loss volume due to the leaks repair. The results indicated that aggressive and efficient leak repair could control the level of real loss effectively.

WSO's final report recommends to continue with the District's current reactive leak repair policy with active leak detection program to be funded in future budgets, conduct input meter and export meter testing periodically, test sample meters on a regular bases, and consider reducing average system pressure for possible further real losses reduction.



SUMMARY:

On October 13, 2009, the Board accepted the request by Mr. Shirloo for consideration of leave to present a late claim and directed staff to review the claim in developing a recommendation to the Board for either rejection of the claim, payment of the claim as presented or some other amount as determined by staff's review.

After compiling and reviewing information submitted by Mr. Shirloo and LVMWD's operation records, staff made the following findings:

On July 21, 2008, a water service connection leak in front of the Mr. Shirloo's home construction site, 3571 Pansy Dr, caused cave-in of two piles with rebar cages in each of the piles. Based on recommendations from Mr. Shirloo's geotechnical engineer and structural engineer, these two piles were abandoned and backfilled with slurry and two new replacement piles were drilled several feet away. In addition, two grade beams were added to connect the two replacement piles/caissons.

Staff performed a review of the invoices submitted by Mr. Shirloo and determined that engineering and inspection services, equipment and material expenses related to the replacement of the two caved-in piles and the construction of two additional grade beams are legitimate and related to the damages. Claims related to concrete and expenses after the construction of the new replacement piles and grade beams are not part of the damage and therefore should not be included. In addition, due to lack of documentation to support claims of labor expenses, staff and Mr. Shirloo agreed on a reasonable amount of labor and site clean cost based on the cost of materials used.

Staff and Mr. Shirloo have agreed on the amount of the claim recommended by staff. Mr. Shirloo will be required to sign a waiver of any future claims associated with the incident.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve the claim in the amount of \$25,214.07.



SUMMARY:

On April 28, 2009 the Board awarded a contract to Instrument Control Services (ICS) in the amount of \$37,391.50. The scope of the project included the installation of weirs and level sensors to automatically measure flow from each of the four seepage points in the dam. These measurements are connected to the SCADA system and recorded. Also added to the scope of work was the installation of additional conduit for the potential future installation of turbidity meters. There were two change orders for this project. Change Order No. 1 in the amount of \$5,034.00 was administratively approved on November 5, 2009, for the relocation of conduit due to field condition conflict, and weir relocation necessary for maintenance access. Change Order No.2 in the amount of \$743.96 was administratively approved on December 16, 2009, for the replacement of an existing conduit with larger conduit.

As of January 8, 2010, the project was completed. It is appropriate at this time to file the Notice of Completion, make the final payment and release retention as stipulated in the Contract.

RECOMMENDATION(S):
