CALABASAS, CA February 9, 2010 – The Las Virgenes –Triunfo Joint Powers Authority will conduct a free public tour of its wastewater treatment and recycling facilities on Saturday, February 27 from 8:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. The tour will begin at LVMWD headquarters, 4232 Las Virgenes Rd. in Calabasas.

Participants must be 12 years of age or older; children under 18 must be accompanied by a responsible adult. Registration is required; interested parties should call 818-251-2200 during business hours. Complimentary breakfast snacks and a light lunch will be provided to participants. Guests should wear comfortable shoes as moderate walking and stairways are encountered during the tour.

"We invite area residents to come see how we treat some 10 million gallons of wastewater every day and return it safely to the environment," said John R. Mundy, Administering Agent / General Manager for the JPA. "Recycling is an important component in helping to extend our regional water supply; we welcome the opportunity to share with the public how we accomplish that mission."
